Dogs with an AX title are eligible to enter Premier Standard Regular. Dogs with an AX or AXP title are eligible to enter Premier Standard Preferred. Dogs with an AXJ title are eligible to enter Premier Jumpers with Weaves Regular. Dogs with an AXJ or AJP title are eligible to enter Premier Jumpers with Weaves Preferred. Dogs with Regular titles may cross over to the Premier Preferred level as noted above.

^{**}Premier Standard and Premier JWW Information and Eligibility: The Premier classes are optional titling classes designed to challenge dogs and handlers at an increased speed and skill level above those set for the Master level classes.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

This trial will not offer entries for All-American Dogs/Mixed Breeds.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at http://www.akc.org/rules. Additional information about the AKC Canine Partners program is located at: www.akccaninepartners.org.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by the B & D Creekside Activity Center. Electronic timers will be used in both rings. All classes will take place indoors on field turf surface.

Ring size will be 95 x 95.

Course Walk-throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an *earlier* group to insure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

"Triple-Q" and "Quad-Q" ribbons will be awarded for dogs who qualify in: 3 of 4 (triple) or 4 out of 4 (quad) classes each day.

Saturday ONLY:

A rosette will be offered to the Highest Scoring Sheltie in either Novice A or B, Open and Excellent or Master classes.

Highest Scoring Sheltie will be determined by score and yards per second If there is a tie, then the dog with the most yards per second prevails.

A qualifying score is required for eligibility

After Closing Waiting List

TRSSCGP is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. Any entries that are withdrawn by Monday, June 13, 2016 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, June 13, 2016 will receive a full refund.

Refund Policy

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The club will refund all but \$8.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason.

Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete, and must be presented to the Trial Secretary by the end of judging on Sunday. The veterinarian note must be dated AFTER the closing date. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

Move-Up Information

Per Chapter 1, Section 20, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made <u>in writing</u> to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials.

Move-ups may be e-mailed, mailed or faxed. Verbal move ups will not be accepted. Please include basic (legible) information: Owner's name, dog's registered name and call name, registration number, class change information. Confirmation of move-up will be sent via e-mail. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately.

Confirmation of entry, move-up or cancellation will be sent via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry.

If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline or entry cancellation by the closing date/time, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately.

Entry method is First Received.

Entries open March 23, 2016 (8 a.m.) at the Trial Secretary's address and will be limited to 660 runs per day. The closing date is June 3, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.

Entry fees are \$25.00 for the 1st run, \$15.00 for each additional run each day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee for the first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry).

Junior Handler entries are free! Junior Handler name and AKC JH number must be included on the entry form. Dogs <u>must</u> be run by the Junior Handler listed on the form. Crating and Set-Up Information:

Exhibitor Setup on Friday Evening: 6:00 - 9:00 PM. Those exhibitors who come in and help unload the equipment trailer will be given priority at set-up time.

Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. Crating space is limited. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave. High occupancy ex-pens (3 dogs or more) ONLY.

Crates may be left overnight. Dogs may **NOT** be left overnight. TRSSCGP will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Crate aggressive dogs or dogs who create a disturbance must be covered and monitored by owners and may not be positioned in heavy traffic areas. The Event Committee may limit or move an exhibitor's crating area if it is in the best interests of the trial.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times, <u>both indoors and outdoors</u>, except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Puppies under the age of four months are prohibited from the trial grounds.
