****Premier class eligibility:** The Premier Standard and JWW classes have a single class level. Dogs eligible to enter Novice, Open, Excellent or Master level classes may enter the Premier class.

Additional information about eligibility and scoring are available in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 11.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <u>http://www.akc.org/rules</u>. Additional information about the AKC Canine Partners program is located at: <u>www.akccaninepartners.org</u>.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by the B & D Creekside Activity Center. Electronic timers will be used in both rings. All classes will take place indoors on field turf surface.

Ring size will be 95 x 95.

Course Walk-throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an *earlier* group to ensure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog.

Ribbons, Awards and Prizes

A rosette will be offered to <u>all</u> dog/handler teams finishing a title. (Including MX, MXP, MXJ, MJP, PAX, PACH and MACH) A bar will be offered to dog/handler teams who finish their MACH or PACH.

> "Double Q" ribbons will be offered for dogs who qualify in: Master STD and Master JWW.

"Triple-Q" and "Quad-Q" ribbons will be awarded for dogs who qualify in: 3 of 4 (triple) or 4 out of 4 (quad) classes each day.

Move-Up Information

Per Chapter 1, Section 20, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials.

Move-ups may be e-mailed, mailed or faxed. Verbal move ups will not be accepted. Please include basic (legible) information: Owner's name, dog's registered name and call name, registration number, class change information. Confirmation of move-up will be sent via e-mail. Refund Policy

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund all but ten (\$10.00) dollars per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season.

Vouchers for future trials will be given for any entered dog where a veterinarian determines that the dog should not run because of a medical condition. A note from a veterinarian is required, stating why the dog may not compete.

Full refund will be made for deceased dogs provided notification is made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial. No vet note required.

All vet notes must be signed, dated after the closing date, on official business letterhead, state the reason that the dog may not compete and presented to the Trial Secretary by the end of the trial on Sunday. Please note: Phone calls, "text only" e-mails, and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. Vet notes may not be written by owner, handler or immediate family member.
