Armbands will be available (self-serve) at the check-in table at the show site (alphabetical by owner).

Check-in for measuring: Begins at 7:00 a.m. Additional measuring time will be provided (as available) as courses are being set. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. **Reminder:** All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request. (We are not expected to have a VMO this weekend.)

Move ups for the trial must be received by 6 p.m. on Monday, September 22.

Parking: Parking is available close to the building. There is Priority Parking for those who will be crating from their vehicles.

Food and beverage: There will be a complimentary homemade lunch for all volunteers and available for anyone else by donation. Food and beverage will not be otherwise available for purchase at the trial site. Other food is available within a short driving distance and of course, exhibitors are free to bring their own!

Crating/setup: The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning for set-up. There is no set-up on Sunday evening. Indoor crating space is somewhat limited, so we ask that you please conserve as much space as possible during your set-up. Please bring a waterproof mat or tarp to place under your crate. No ex-pens, please. Outdoor crating space available—please bring your own shelter/shade. The site is located at a private residence and it is very safe to work out of your vehicle. There will not be any traffic that is not directly related to the trial. You may also wish to bring a chair.

The worker schedule will be sent via e-mail by the Tuesday before the trial. Please check in with our Ring Princess, Ruth Bryden at the trial site often to see how you can help! Directions to Bella Vista Training Center:

From I-83

I-83 to Exit 32 (Newberrytown Exit - old exit #13), Rt. 382 North to Lewisberry, approximately 3 miles to flashing traffic light.

South (Left) on Rt. 177 toward Rossville, approximately 3 miles.

Right on Mt. Airy Rd. (across from Lake Pinchot Park Office), 1.7 miles site on left.

From US-15

RT. 15 to Mechanicsburg - Bowmansdale Exit, Rt. 114 towards Ski Roundtop,

At the traffic light at the bottom of the hill, proceed straight on South Market Street, DO NOT FOLLOW 114, continue straight about 2.3 miles on South Market (it will become North York Rd).

Left on East Mt. Airy Rd (at Mt. Pleasant Church of God) and go 4.5 miles, pass Ski Roundtop (on right) continue to "T" intersection,

Right on Pinetown Rd., First Left on Mt. Airy Road. Site is immediately on the right.

Classes will be run concurrently (**B, A, Preferred**) within height divisions in the following order:

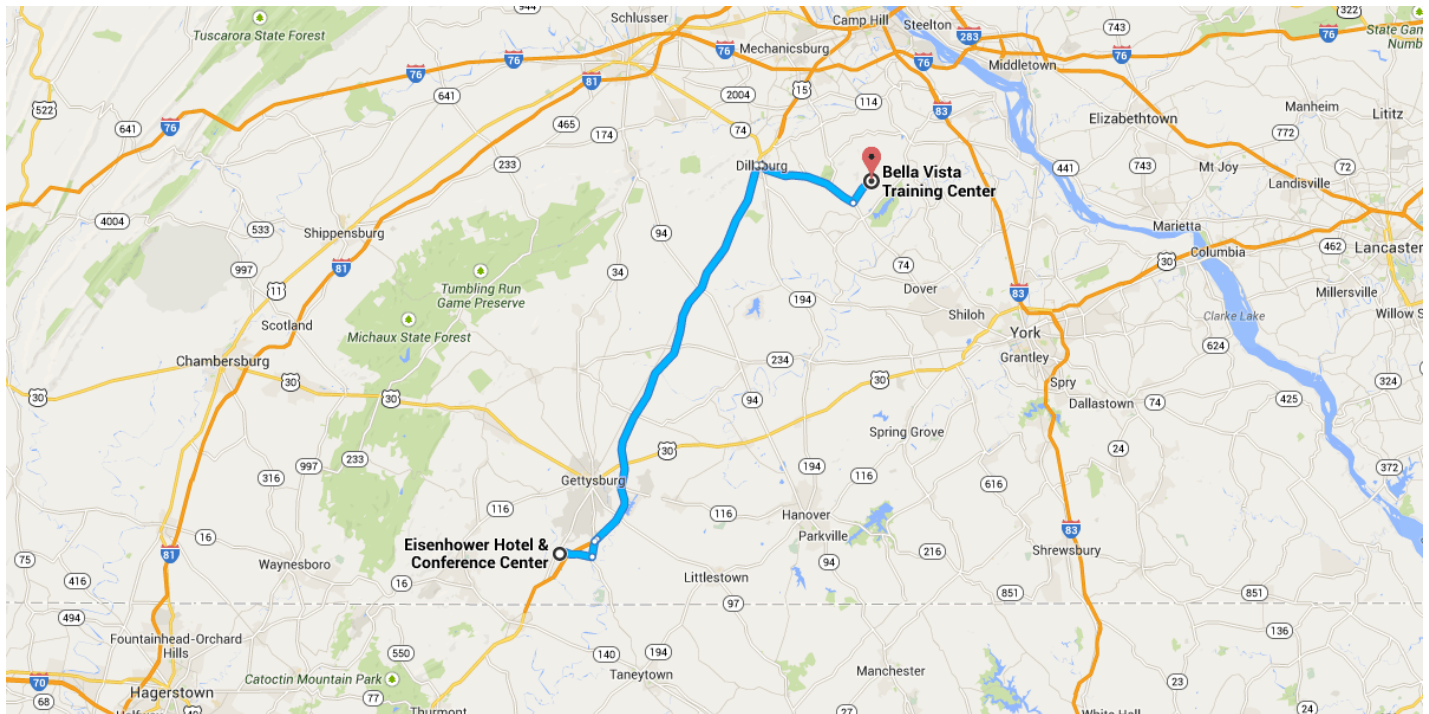

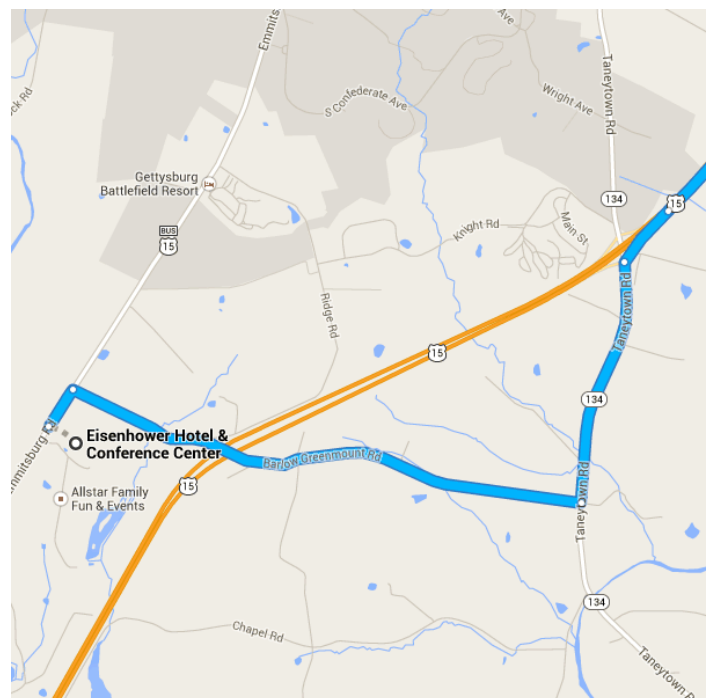
Get on **US-15 N** from **Barlow Greenmount Rd** and **PA-134 N**
