Armband Numbers / Check-In:

Armbands will be available at the check-in table (alphabetical by owner). Gate sheets will be available for check-in **only**. Any changes in running order must be done by the Gate Steward for the class.

Check-in for Measuring: Begins each day at 7:00 a.m. Additional measuring time will be provided (as available) as courses are being set. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. We are not expected to have a measuring official at the trial. Dogs needing to be measured should be measured by one of the judges before running, and the measurement will be good for this weekend of trials only. Reminder: All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card if requested.

Move ups for the April 3 trial must be received by 6 p.m. on Monday, March 30. Move-ups for Friday-Saturday or Saturday-Sunday will be allowed and must be submitted within ½ hour of the end of judging each day. The move-up book will be located on the check-in table. Just fill out your move-up form and leave it in the book. Magically, your move-up will happen overnight. ☺

Parking: See parking instructions on next page.

Crating/setup: The building will be available on Friday morning immediately after all equipment is unloaded (approximately 6:30 a.m.) NO SET-UPS or site accessibility on Thursday evening. Water ONLY in the crating area, please.

Crating space is limited, so plan on getting cozy with your neighbor and sharing where you can. There is additional crating space upstairs. Due to space limitations, unentered dogs may be asked to leave. High occupancy ex-pens (3 dogs or more) only.

The terms of the facility contract make it necessary for us to completely clear BOTH RINGS after the end of the Friday trial (ONLY) for other scheduled events on Friday evening. ALL crates, chairs, etc. must be removed from the fields (only). We will not have to clear either ring after the Saturday trial. FISC expects to have a room available so that "stuff" can be stored so that it does not have to be taken back to your car, and we'll have more info at the trial. Those crated upstairs will not have to move.

Food and refreshments will be available at the trial site.

We wish to thank all those who have volunteered to help at this trial. Any and all assistance makes for a smoother running trial, so please check with the volunteer coordinator in each ring often to see how you can help! There will be a volunteer raffle each day. Volunteer coupons will be given for each class worked, good towards purchase at the Replay Café, future entries, use at vendors (if present) or charity (AKC Canine Health Foundation or American Cancer Society). Thank you for volunteering!

Remember! Keep the area clean! As always, exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up any deposits left by their dog. Any exhibitor failing to pick up after their dog will be EXCUSED without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor is in violation of this requirement. While the use of flexi-leads is not prohibited on show grounds, we urge you to use them responsibly. Failure to properly control a dog at an event can be grounds for a misconduct hearing. Let's keep this site dog friendly! ☺

Directions: The **Frederick Indoor Sports Center** is located at 1845 Brookfield Ct., Frederick, MD 21701.

From Route 70, merge onto US-40 toward US-15 N/Gettysburg (US-40 becomes US-15 N). Merge onto MD-26 E/Liberty Rd. via Exit 17 toward MD-194/Libertytown/Walkersville. Take the 1st right onto Routzahns Way/MD-355. Take 1st right onto Wormans Mill Ct. Take the 1st left onto Brookfield Ct. FISC is on the right.

Parking - Special Instructions

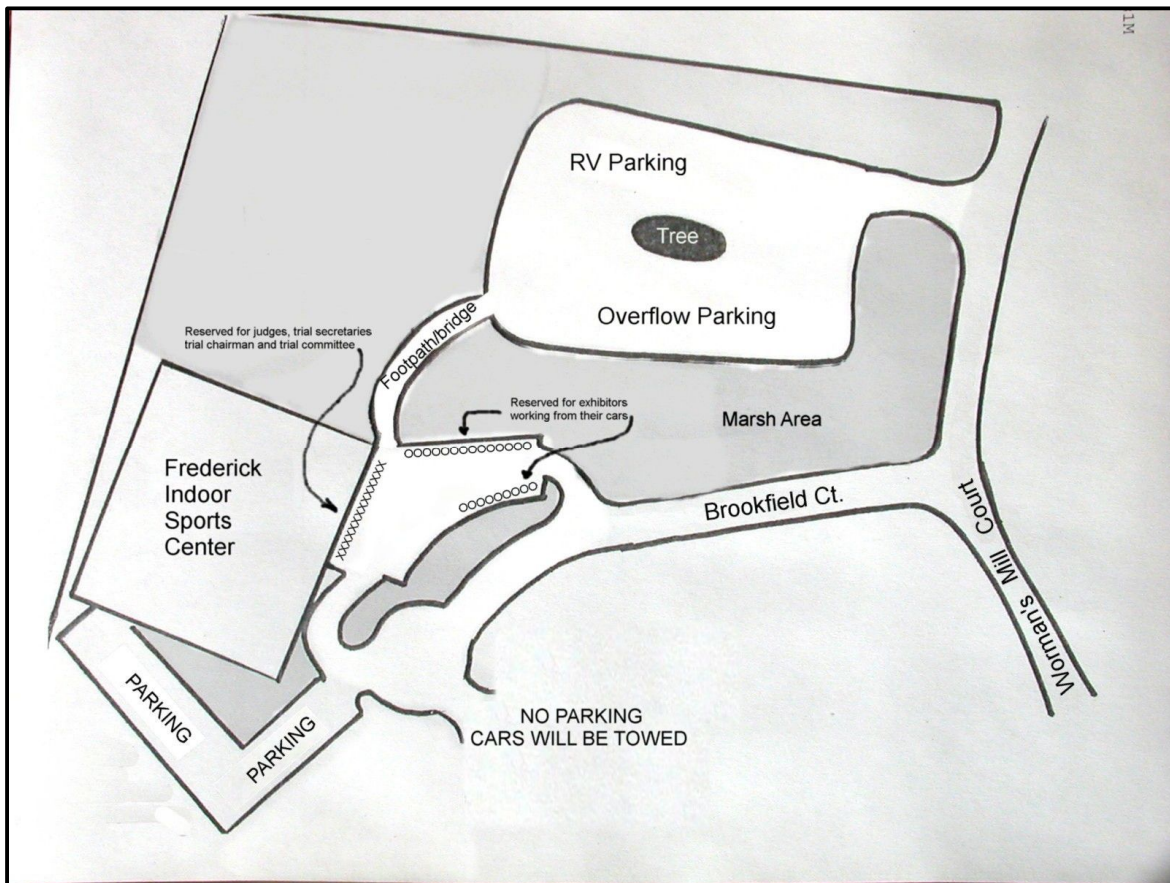
The parking map below clearly outlines available parking. **Do not park in the parking areas of the businesses directly across from the Sports Center. You WILL be towed.**

Some parking places in front of the building are reserved for FISC employees and tenants. The facility will post signs at these places, so please look for them and avoid these spots.

Parking places directly in front of the building are reserved for show committee. Exhibitors working solely from their cars (not crating in the building) will be given priority on other spaces in front of the building on a first-come, first-served basis.

Unloading: You may unload at the front entrances. There is also access to the building from the side.

Motorhome Parking: Parking for motorhomes is available at the show site (in the area marked "Overflow Parking"). No reservation is required. Your cooperation is appreciated.

"Capital Challenge" 2-dog Pair Competition

This non-regular class will be open to dogs eligible to compete in regular AKC agility classes.

The event will take place immediately following the regular classes in the first available ring on Saturday. Regulation AKC agility equipment will be used, no modifications.

The course will be a "nested" course - Path 1 (longer, more challenging) / Path 2 (simpler, shorter), run by a "pair" of 2 handlers and 2 dogs of the same jump height (regular or preferred - does not matter). Both Paths must be run, each by a different dog. Path 1 will be longer and more difficult; Path 2 will be simpler and shorter, giving all levels of competitors the chance to participate.

There will be 2 tables, which will be the start/end of each "path". Path 1 will be run first. When Dog 1 finishes the course and reaches the table, Dog 2 may immediately begin Path 2. The timer stops when Dog 2 reaches the table at the end of their course. Lowest cumulative time wins.

Scoring:

No refusals

Wrong course: + 5 seconds

Dropped Bar: + 5 seconds

Dog #2 leaves the start table early: + 10 seconds

Pairs may not be duplicated, but each dog can be on a maximum of 3 different pairs. Sign up as a pair *or* have the club pair you with someone else that has signed up in the same jump height.

Prizes will be awarded for the winning pair in each jump height.

Come and join us in the fun!! Sign-up is on the day of the event.

Entry fee is \$5 per person/per run.

Entry fees for the "Capital Challenge" will be donated to charity!
