Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

#### **Measuring and Height Card Information**

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

## **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

# **Obstacles and Ring Conditions**

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by MAD Agility. Electronic timers will be used in both rings.

All classes will take place indoors on field turf surface (Sprinturf). Ring size will be 80 x 110.

# Course Walk-throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an \*earlier\* group to insure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

## Ribbons, Awards and Prizes

A rosette will be offered to <u>all</u> dog/handler teams finishing a title.
(Including MX, MXP, MXJ, MJP, PAX, PACH and MACH)
A bar will be offered to dog/handler teams who finish their MACH or PACH.
A ribbon will be given for a double-Q earned from the Master class.

## **After Closing Waiting List**

CDTC is not offering an after closing waiting list for this trial. Any exhibitor that wishes to withdraw must do so before the published closing date and time.

#### **Move-Up Information**

Per Chapter 1, Section 20, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made <u>in writing</u> to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials.

Move-ups may be e-mailed, mailed or faxed. Verbal move ups will not be accepted. Please include basic (legible) information: Owner's name, dog's registered name and call name, registration number, class change information. Confirmation of move-up will be sent via e-mail. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately.

Day-to-day move ups will be allowed between the trial dates and will be taken up to one-half hour after the conclusion of the last class each day. These move-ups must be submitted in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary.

#### Online Entries

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: Thirty percent (30%) of entries per day available for online entry, seventy percent (70%) of entries per day for paper entries. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Online Entries will receive a confirming email from LabTestedOnline which will be considered the initial entry confirmation. All changes to online entries before closing MUST be done through the online entry website to ensure that payment is correct. Final confirmation will be received from the Trial Secretary at closing.

Fax/Credit Card Entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. ## **Notice to Exhibitors**

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. Crating space is limited. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave. High occupancy ex-pens (3 dogs or more) ONLY.

The terms of the facility contract make it necessary for us to <u>completely</u> clear BOTH RINGS after the end of the Friday trial (ONLY) for other scheduled events on Friday evening. ALL crates, chairs, etc. must be removed. We will not have to clear either ring after the Saturday trial.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**: Crate aggressive dogs or dogs who create a disturbance must be covered and monitored by owners and may not be positioned in heavy traffic areas. The Event Committee may limit or move an exhibitor's crating area if it is in the best interests of the trial.

Dogs MAY NOT be left overnight. Capital Dog Training Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Food will be available on site all three days. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on site.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$10.00 with your entry. A very limited number of catalogs will be available for sale on the trial date.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

CDTC and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

CDTC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

## **Refund Policy**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund all but eight (\$8.00) dollars per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season.

All notes must be signed, dated, on official business letterhead and presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

# "Capital Challenge" 2-dog Pair Competition

This non-regular class will be open to dogs eligible to compete in regular AKC agility classes.

The event will take place immediately following the regular classes on Saturday. Regulation AKC agility equipment will be used, no modifications.

The course will be a "nested" course (Path 1 "Big" / Path 2 "Small"), run by a "pair" of 2 handlers and 2 dogs of the same jump height (regular or preferred - does not matter). Both Paths must be run, each by a different dog. Path 1 will be longer and more difficult; Path 2 will be simpler and shorter, giving all levels of competitors the chance to participate.

There will be 2 tables, which will be the start/end of each "path". Path 1 will be run first. When Dog 1 finishes the course and reaches the table, Dog 2 may immediately begin Path 2. The timer stops when Dog 2 reaches the table at the end of their course. Lowest cumulative time wins.

#### Scoring:

No refusals

Wrong course: + 5 seconds Dropped Bar: + 5 seconds

Dog #2 leaves the start table early: + 10 seconds

Pairs may not be duplicated, but each dog can be on a maximum of 3 different pairs.

Prizes will be awarded for the winning pair in each jump height.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by *a* Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
