● COVID-19 “Stuff” – Policies, Restrictions and Whatnot:

The Covid-19 pandemic is an ever-changing situation. It is our wish to make sure all in attendance stay safe and every precaution will be taken. Oriole Dog Training Club’s mask policy is based on the CDC Baltimore County Community Transmission Status. Please see more information on the club website: <http://www.orioledogclub.org>.

IMPORTANT:

If you are exhibiting signs of illness or have been otherwise told to self-quarantine due to known COVID-19 exposure, please stay home.

- Crating will be allowed inside the building. There is no occupancy restriction. However, social distancing guidelines should still be followed as much as possible with people outside your immediate social circle. This includes interactions with judge, volunteers, club members and other exhibitors.

- As of the publishing of this judging schedule, masks will not be required inside the building. If this policy changes, announcement will be made and signs posted. Please come prepared with your own mask, none will be provided.

Leashes: You may run with your leash in your pocket (must fit fully) or wear them while running the course. Don’t drop it!

Course maps: Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be sent to exhibitors via email each morning. (I will make every effort to send around 6:00 AM.) NOTE: AKC is no longer allowing course maps to be provided the evening before the trial. They will be posted at the trial site, as well, so come prepared to photograph the map for personal use.

Briefings/walkthroughs: See judging schedule page for briefing/walkthrough schedule.

● And now, the REGULAR “Stuff”!

Check-in for measuring: A Measuring Official will not be present at this trial. NOTE: The AKC has returned to the policy of measuring all dogs that do not have a height card. Even if a VMO is not present, all dogs that do not have a height card will need to be measured by the judge of record (if no VMO is present) prior to their first run.

Crating/setup:

FRIDAY: The trial site will be open at 4:00 PM on Friday for set-up – NO DOGS. Dogs will be allowed in the building at 5:00 PM.

IMPORTANT!! NO DOGS IN THE BUILDING PRIOR TO 5:00 PM ON FRIDAY.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY: The building will open at 6:45 AM each trial day on Saturday and Sunday.

Flooring Restrictions:

A waterproof pad is required under all crates. Only WATER is allowed on the turf flooring—no other type of beverage.

Crumbly dog treats are not allowed on the turf flooring. Soft dog treats are allowed. Food, gum and drinks other than water will not be allowed on the field turf flooring. Please exercise your dog often. If there is an accident, there is a charge of \$5 to offset the cost of cleaning of the turf.

Recording/videoing for personal use is not prohibited as long as it does not obstruct aisles/walkways, disturb other exhibitors, dogs, or judge(s).

Those using video must be cognizant of both intentional and ambient audio. These devices may not be used near the trial secretary/judge/club working areas or placed behind timer/scribe working in the ring.

Food will not be available at the trial site. Please plan on packing your lunch. Fast food is available nearby.

Parking: There is plenty of parking near the building. Please follow any signage that may be present.

Limited daytime RV Parking is available. No electric, no hookup. Contact Rhonda Toren (agilitysec@clantyre.net) for additional information.

Move ups for the December 9 trial must be received by 6 PM on Monday, December 5. Move-ups Saturday-Sunday will be allowed and must be submitted within ½ hour of the end of judging each day. (To make your Trial Secretary happier, you can move up as soon as you get done celebrating your new title rather than leaving it to the end of the day.) 😊 The move-up book will be located near the Trial Secretary. Look for it around the table with the score monitors.

Directions to the trial site:

From 95 North: Take Exit 50A-50B onto Caton Ave toward South Washington. Keep right onto Caton Ave S toward Washington Blvd. Turn right onto Joh Ave. Turn left onto Benson Ave. Turn left onto Knecht Ave. Turn left onto Azar Ct, #9 is on the right.

From Interstate 695/Baltimore Beltway: Take Exit 11A-11B for Interstate 95 South towards Washington. Keep right and follow signs for Sulphur Springs Rd. Turn right onto Sulphur Springs Rd (signs say Arbutus/Violetville). Take the first right onto Benson Ave. Take a right onto Knecht Ave. Turn left onto Azar Ct, #9 is on the right.

As always, exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up any deposits left by their dog.

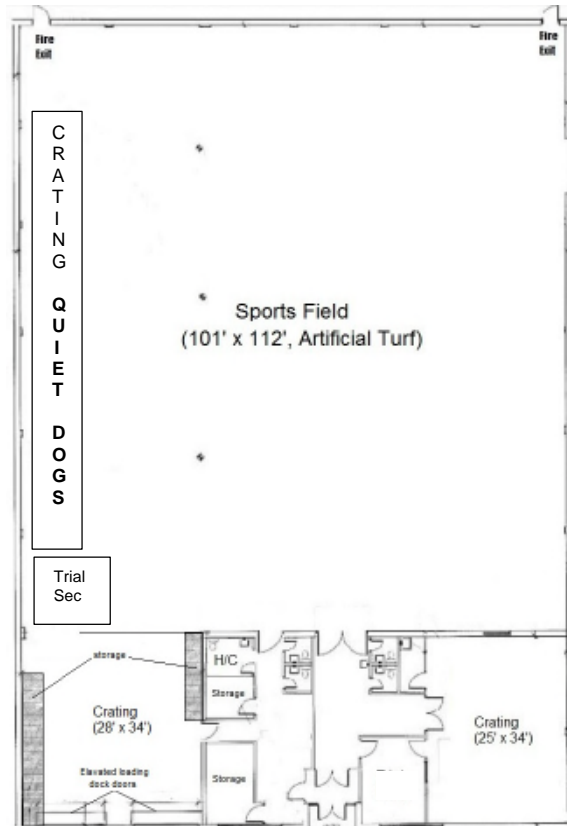

Crating & Facility Information

We ask that exhibitors be considerate of others regarding crating space. There are a number of rooms in the front part of the building which will be marked as crating areas. There is limited crating next to the ring, which can be used if the dog in the crate is well-behaved. Crating space is extremely limited, so plan on getting cozy with your neighbor and sharing where you can. Crates have priority. Ex-pens are allowed but must contain 3 or more dogs. If there is insufficient space, you will be asked to remove chairs from the crating area. Due to space limitations, unentered dogs may be asked to leave.

The Event Committee may limit or move an exhibitor’s crating area if it is in the best interests of the trial.

 (“Saving space” for those not in attendance will not be allowed.)**
