Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Crating and Set-up Information:

Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. High occupancy ex-pens (3 dogs or more) ONLY.

We will have a number of priority parking spaces available for those who are willing to work from their cars.

No set-up time available on Thursday evening. The building will not be available until Friday morning. Set-up will be allowed after the rings have been set. Those exhibitors who come in and help unload the trailer will be given priority at set-up time ☺

Crating will not be allowed in the JWW ring on Friday.

Since crating space is limited, Unentered dogs may be asked to leave the crating area.

Crate aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned on the corners of aisles or other heavy traffic areas. This will be strictly enforced. If complaints are received, dogs will be moved.

REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The club will refund 50% of the entry fee for bitches in season or injured (not sick) dogs that are unable to compete for that reason.

Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete, and must be presented to the Trial Secretary by the start of judging on Friday. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. SSCGB and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Dogs MAY NOT be left overnight. The Shetland Sheepdog Club of Greater Baltimore will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

Motorhomes requiring a spot larger than a standard 7' x 18' space must be parked in the Lower lot. (*Strictly enforced.*) Overnight parking is allowed in the Lower lot only, with reservation (see Motorhome Information.)

Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$15.00 with your entry. A very limited number of catalogs will be available for sale on the trial date.

Good Food will be available on site.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Confirmation of entry, move-up or cancellation will be sent via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. (It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their e-mail address is legible and that messages will be accepted from ajilitysec@clantyre.net.)

Entries open Tuesday, February 12, 2013 (8 a.m.) at the Trial Secretary's address and will be limited to 660 Excellent/Master STD, JWW & FAST and Time2Beat runs on Friday and 660 runs per day on Saturday and Sunday. The method of entry is **First Received**. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after the opening date and time. Entries close Friday, April 12, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.

Entry fees are \$19.00 for the 1st run, \$19.00 for the 2nd run and \$14.00 for each additional run per dog, each day. (Includes AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry per dog per day. Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.)

Make checks payable (in US funds) to **SSCGB** (or **Shetland Sheepdog Club of Greater Baltimore**).

Express Mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left without recipient signature.

Online Entries

This trial is accepting online entries through **LabTestedOnline.com**.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 60 entries per day available for online entry, 600 entries per day paper entries. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Fax/Credit Card Entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. (Agility fax/credit card entries are accepted under the rules of "first received," and cannot be processed in the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.) Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (**Visa, MasterCard or Discover**) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. (There is a cover sheet available for download on the web site: <http://www.clantyre.net>).

The fax fee is \$4.00 per dog. All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. You may wish to call to confirm receipt of your fax, as proof of transmission is not proof of receipt. (Phone: 410-997-3698)

PLEASE MAKE YOUR ENTRIES LEGIBLE. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards **do not** constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. (Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.)

Due to the cost of processing, over-payments of \$5 or less will be donated to our Sheltie Rescue program.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Greater Baltimore.

All classes will take place indoors on field "Sprinturf" surface. Ring size will be 80' x 110'. Electronic timers will be used in both rings. Weave pole spacing is 24". Rubberized contacts will be used.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an *earlier* group to insure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each Standard, JWW & FAST class as follows:

First Prize.....	Blue Rosette
Second Prize.....	Red Rosette
Third Prize.....	Yellow Rosette
Fourth Prize.....	White Rosette
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green Ribbon

A rosette will be offered to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.
(Including MX, MXP, MXJ, MJP, PAX, PACH and MACH)

A bar will be offered to dog/handler teams who finish their "MACH" or "PACH."

"AFTER CLOSING" WAITING LIST

SSCGB is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. Any entries that are withdrawn by Monday, April 22, 2013 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, April 22, 2013 will receive a full refund.

MOVE-UP INFORMATION

Move-ups must be sent in writing to the Trial Secretary for the Friday trial no later than the Monday preceding the trial at 6 p.m. These may be faxed, mailed or e-mailed. **Day-to-day move ups will be allowed between the trial dates and must be submitted in person to the Trial Secretary by the end of judging each day.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
