Armband Numbers and Check-In: Armbands will be available at the check-in table (alphabetical by owner).

Check-in for measuring: Begins both days at 8:00 a.m. Additional measuring time will be provided (as available) as courses are being set. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. **Reminder:** All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request.

We expect an AKC Field Representative to be present. If you do not have a permanent height card, your dog MUST be measured for one. Remember to bring your dog's information with you (particularly AKC number) so that you can fill out the Measurement Form prior to being measured.

Move ups for the October 18 trial must be received by 6 p.m. on Monday, October 15. Moveups will be allowed between the October 18 and October 19 trial dates and must be submitted in person to the trial secretary by the end of judging on Thursday, October 18. The "Move-Up" book will be located on the check-in table.

FROM DC/VIRGINIA: From DC Beltway (I-495), take I-270 exit towards Frederick. From I-270, take Father Hurley Blvd/Damascus exit, which becomes Rt 27/Ridge Rd. Stay on Rt 27 North about 20 miles. After crossing intersection at Rt 26, continue on Rt 27 North about 2 miles. Turn right onto Magin Lane (directly across from the driveway of Calvary Baptist Church). Follow agility signs, almost 1 mile.

FROM BALTIMORE: From Baltimore Beltway (I-695), take Exit 19 (I-795). Continue until I-795 ends, bearing right onto Route 140 West/Westminster. Follow Rt 140 west for about 10 miles. At Town Mall, get in right lane & take exit ramp to Route 27 South. At end of ramp, turn left onto Route 27. Go about 8 miles. Turn left onto Magin Lane (directly across from the driveway of Calvary Baptist Church). Follow agility signs, almost 1 mile.

FROM I-70: Take Exit 68 (Rt 27) towards Mt. Airy/Westminster. Continue on Rt 27 North about 9 miles. After crossing intersection at Rt 26, continue on Rt 27 North about 2 miles. Turn right onto Magin Lane (directly across from the driveway of Calvary Baptist Church). Follow agility signs, almost 1 mile.

Parking: Parking is available close to the ring on the grass. Please obey all signs and parking attendants!!
No RV's, please, due to space limitations. There is no overnight parking at the show site. Please do not block the driveway.



IMPORTANT NOTICE! The road to the agility site is a single-lane driveway with a speed limit of 15 miles per hour.
Please go **SLOWLY** and watch for on-coming vehicles.

Heart's Home Farm is a Christmas tree farm. Please do **NOT** allow your dogs to relieve themselves on the Christmas trees!!



No food vendor on site: A light lunch will be available to all workers free-of-charge. A Little George's Convenience Store with sandwiches and subs is 1 mile away. A New York J & P Pizza is 2 miles away.

Crating/setup: **NO SET-UP** is available on Wednesday evening. There is plenty of space, as this is an outdoor trial. ☺
