Armbands* will be available (self-serve) at the check-in table at the show site (alphabetical by owner). Armbands for the entire weekend are in your envelope. I encourage you to leave your Saturday armband in the box for safekeeping ©

Check-in for measuring: Begins on Friday at 8:00 a.m., Saturday at 7:15 a.m. Additional measuring time will be provided (as available) as courses are being set. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Reminder: All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request. (We are not expected to have a VMO this weekend.)

Move ups for the September 23 trial must be received by 6 p.m. on Monday, September 19. Moveups will be allowed between the September 23 and September 24 trial dates and must be submitted in person to the trial secretary by the end of judging on Friday, September 23.

Parking: We are using the <u>lower</u> building ONLY. Paved parking is located close to the building. Please do NOT block the driveways. Due to space limitations, **RVs** that do not fit completely within the confines of a regular 7 x 18 parking space are strictly prohibited. **No ex-pens** in the parking area. There is no overnight parking at the show site.

Food and refreshments will be available at the trial site.

Crating/setup: There will be plenty of crating space. Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. Set-up **will** be available on Thursday night ONLY for those willing to seriously help unload and set-up the site! Equipment/site set-up is from 7:00 – 8:30 p.m. NO crate set-up will be allowed until everything is in place! **The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. each day.**

Directions to Carroll Indoor Sports Center:

From **Baltimore**: From Baltimore Beltway (I-695) take Exit 19, Northwest Expressway

(I-795) towards Owings Mills/Reisterstown. Continue until the Expressway ends, bear right onto Route 140 West. Follow 140 West for approx. 10 miles, turn left onto Route 97 (Weis Market on right, PetSmart on the left.) At the 2nd light, turn Left onto Old Westminster Pike. The Carroll Indoor Sports Center will be on the right a short distance after the turn.

From **DC & Virginia:** From DC Beltway (I-495) take I-270 exit towards Frederick. From 270, take Damascus exit (Route 27 North). Stay on 27 North approx. 25 miles to Main Street in Westminster. Turn right onto Main Street. Go 1.5 miles. C.I.S.C. will be on right side of road after crossing over Route 97.
