Check-In:

Your check in will be at the posted gate sheets. Any changes in running order must be done by the Gate Steward for the class.

Check-in for measuring: Begins each day at 7:00 AM and available throughout the day. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. We do not expect a Measuring Official at the trial. All dogs without temporary or permanent height cards will need to be measured by the judge prior to running. This measurement will be valid for this weekend of trials only. Reminder: All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card, should they be asked, upon request.

As always, exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up any deposits left by their dog. Any exhibitor failing to pick up after their dog will be EXCUSED without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor is in violation of this requirement.

Crating/setup: The trial site will be open at 7:00 AM each trial day. See crating map and important facility information on page 2.

Flooring Restrictions:

A waterproof pad is required under all crates. Only WATER is allowed on the turf flooring-no other type of beverage.

Crumbly dog treats are not allowed on the turf flooring. Soft dog treats are allowed. Food, gum and drinks other than water will not be allowed on the field turf flooring. Please exercise your dog often. If there is an accident, there is a charge of \$5 to offset the cost of cleaning of the turf.

There is no food available on-site. (Pre-ordered sandwiches will be available on Saturday.) Fast food is available nearby.

Parking: There is plenty of parking near the building. There will be a few extra marked Handicapped slots available, first-come, first-served. The cross-hatched "loading dock" spaces closest to the front door of the building may be used for those working out of their cars for ONLY if the weather permits. They will not be policed; it's an "honor system" style of parking.

Limited daytime RV Parking is available. No electric, no hookup. Contact Cindy Deubler (<u>rosiepup@verizon.net</u>) for additional information.

Move ups for the September 21 trial must be received by 6 PM on Monday, September 16. Move-ups Saturday-Sunday will be allowed and must be submitted within ½ hour of the end of judging each day. The move-up book will be located on the check-in table.

"Potty" Instructions




As always, exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up any deposits left by their dog.

Any exhibitor using areas marked as "DO NOT POTTY" and/or failing to pick up after their dog will be EXCUSED without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor is in violation of this requirement.

Crating & Facility Information

There is plenty of crating space, but we ask that exhibitors be considerate of others. There are a number of rooms in the front part of the building which will be marked as crating areas. High occupancy ex-pens (3 dogs or more) will be allowed in the front rooms (not at the ringside area). There is limited crating next to the ring, which can be used if the dog using the crate is well-behaved. Plan on getting cozy with your neighbor and sharing where you can. Crates have priority.

The Event Committee may limit or move an exhibitor's crating area if it is in the best interests of the trial.



Directions to Oriole Dog Training Club:

GPS systems can find many creative paths. (Some GPS units do not have Azar Court; if you have one of them, use 4601 Benson Avenue to get to the cross street).

Coming from Woodlawn via I-695 South:

Follow I-695S. Take Exit 11A-11B as if you are going to go south on I-95. Stay in the rightmost lane and take the exit for Sulphur Spring Rd.

Turn right onto Sulphur Spring Rd.

At the light, turn right onto Benson Ave. Go 0.8 miles on Benson Ave. (If you pass the firehouse on your left, you've gone too far).

About midway to the top of a small hill, turn right onto Knecht Ave, then make an immediate left into Azar Ct.

Coming from Glen Burnie via I-695 North:

Take Exit 10 for Washington Boulevard toward U.S. Route 1. Turn left onto Washington Blvd and work yourself into the right lane.

At the light, turn right onto Sulphur Spring Rd. Go 0.7 miles on Sulphur Spring.

At the light, turn right onto Benson Ave. Go 0.8 miles on Benson Ave. (If you pass the firehouse on your left, you've gone too far).

About midway to the top of a small hill, turn right onto Knecht Ave, then make an immediate left into Azar Ct.

Via I-95 North or South (option 1)

Take Exit 50A-B for Caton Ave.

Keep left to continue on Exit 50B, following signs for N Wilkens Ave.

Take Exit 50A to merge onto S Caton Ave. At the first light, turn right onto Joh Ave. Go 0.7 miles on Joh Ave. At the light, turn left onto Benson Ave. Go 0.5 miles on Benson Ave.

Shortly after seeing the firehouse on your right, turn left onto Knecht Ave, then make an immediate left into Azar Ct.

Via I-95 North or South (option 2, which avoids the rather bumpy Joh Rd but is probably not your best bet at rush hour)

Take Exit 50A-B for Caton Ave. Continue on Exit 50B, following signs for N Wilkens Ave.

Merge onto Caton Ave and start to work yourself into the left lane. At the first full traffic light, turn left onto Benson Ave. Go 1.1 miles on Benson Ave.

Shortly after seeing the firehouse on your right, turn left onto Knecht Ave, then make an immediate left into Azar Ct.

Judging Schedule

Running Order as of September 6, 2019

This is a preliminary judging schedule which is contingent upon move-ups that have not yet been received.

This is a one-ring trial. The first official briefing and walk-through will begin each day 8:00 AM. First dog on the line at 8:15 AM.

Exc/Master Standard and JWW will have 2 walk-throughs: 16", 12/8" Novice, Open and Premier Standard & JWW and Time2Beat will have 1 walk-through per class. FAST will have one combined walk-through.

Lunch Break to be taken at Judge's discretion.
