Important "Covid-19" Trial Info



Please read! We want you to know what to expect before entering.



Here's the most important part:
For 2020, we're going back OUTDOORS!

- As of the publishing of this premium, we expect the trial to go on as described. All trial decisions will be in accordance with Maryland state and local guidelines in place at the time of the trial.
- **NOTE: Late Closing Date: Friday, September 11 at 6:00 PM.**
- The closing date has been adjusted to be just one week prior to the trial. In the event that the trial needs to be canceled because of virus restrictions, we will notify all exhibitors via email no later than the closing date. (Checks will not be cashed, entry fees for those entering via LabTestedOnline will be refunded.) After closing, the refund policy as detailed in this premium will remain in effect.

Other things you can expect on trial days:

- We're back outdoors! Leave some "social space" between cars when parking, expect to work from your car. **RV Parking will be available!**
- Bring your ez-up if you'd like some shade. The "club tent" will be for trial committee/trial secretary/judge only.
- Social distancing will remain in effect. Masks are expected to be required in the club area and when entering and exiting the ring. We will follow state/local guidelines at the time of the trial. Masks will not be required when running the course.
- Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be displayed in several places, and we may be able to email/post them to a website early each day. Come prepared to photograph the map for your personal use.
- The gate steward will be the only person to check in dogs.
- Food will not be available onsite. Plan on bringing your own lunch, water, drinks, ice, etc.
- Briefings/walkthroughs: Expect distance briefings, smaller walkthroughs. Briefings are not required for Excellent/Master classes.
- Ribbons will not be self-serve. Results will be posted in a couple of different places and will be emailed individually to exhibitors after the trial.
- For the rest of 2020, AKC is allowing exhibitors to run with leashes in pocket (must fit fully) or wear them when running course. Don't drop it!
- Exhibitors are expected to follow state, local government, event and facility guidelines. Full details will be included in the judging schedule.

SSCGB is once again planning a great trial! We want to make sure that you know how agility trials have changed for 2020 so that you can make an informed decision before entering. We hope to see you there!!



AKC Class Changes, Effective January 1, 2020

◆ Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

◆ Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

◆ Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

- Toys are allowed in the ring
- Toys must be non-audible
- Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring. A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to Shetland Sheepdogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules>.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Move-Up Information

Per Chapter 1, Section 20, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials.

Move-ups may be e-mailed or mailed. Verbal move ups will not be accepted. Please include basic (legible) information: Owner's name, dog's registered name and call name, registration number, class change information. Confirmation of move-up will be sent via e-mail. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately.

Day-to-day move ups will be allowed between the trial dates and will be taken up to one-half hour after the conclusion of the last class each day. These move-ups must be submitted in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Greater Baltimore.

All classes will take place OUTDOORS on grass surface. Ring size will be 100 x 100. Electronic timers will be used.

Course Walk-throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an *earlier* group to insure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Ribbons, Awards and Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green Ribbon

A rosette will be offered to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.
(Including MX, MXP, MXJ, MJP, MXF, MFP, PAD, PJD, PADP, PJDP
PAX, PACH and MACH)

A bar will be offered to dog/handler teams who finish their MACH or PACH.

FROM DC/VIRGINIA: From DC Beltway (I-495), take I-270 exit towards Frederick. From I-270, take Father Hurley Blvd/Damascus exit, which becomes Rt 27/Ridge Rd. Stay on Rt 27 North about 20 miles. After crossing intersection at Rt 26, continue on Rt 27 North about 2 miles. Turn right onto Magin Lane, which is directly across from Calvary Baptist Church. Follow agility signs, almost 1 mile.

FROM BALTIMORE: From Baltimore Beltway (I-695), take Exit 19 (I-795). Continue until I-795 ends, bearing right onto Route 140 West/Westminster. Follow Rt 140 west for about 10 miles. At Town Mall, get in right lane & take exit ramp to Route 27 South. At end of ramp, turn left onto Route 27. Go about 8 miles. Turn left onto Magin Lane, which is directly across from Calvary Baptist Church. Follow agility signs, almost 1 mile.

FROM I-70: Take Exit 68 (Rt 27) towards Mt. Airy/Westminster. Continue on Rt 27 North about 9 miles. After crossing intersection at Rt 26, continue on Rt 27 North about 2 miles. Turn right onto Magin Lane, which is directly across from Calvary Baptist Church. Follow agility signs, almost 1 mile.

Refund Policy

Notes from a Veterinarian are required for all refunds except as noted below. *

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund 50% of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason.

Medical Condition: Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury or illness where a veterinarian determines that the dog should not run will be given a partial refund (50%) of entry fees.

Kennel Cough/K9 Influenza: Any dog diagnosed with a communicable disease AND any other dog in the household entered in the trial will be given a partial refund (50%) of entry fees.

(Dogs and their housemates are ineligible to enter any AKC sanctioned event for 30 days past the date of diagnosis of communicable disease (Chapter 11, Section 9 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.)

Deceased Dog: Full refund will be made provided the Trial Secretary receives written or emailed notification prior to the start of the trial. No Vet note required.

Clubs must list in the premium all situations for which they will provide a refund. Refunds will not be made for any circumstance other than those listed. This includes but is not limited to injured handlers, death in the family, other owner/handler emergencies. Clubs/Trial Chairs/Trial Secretaries cannot make exceptions or honor refund requests for situations not listed. (AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 9.)

*All veterinarian notes must be signed, dated after the closing date, on official business letterhead and presented to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of judging on the last day of the trial. After that time, refund requests will not be accepted. Please note: Phone calls, "text only" emails and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. Vet notes may not be written by owner, handler or immediate family member.

Confirmation of entry, move-up or cancellation will be sent via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline or entry cancellation by the closing date/time, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately. Entry fees are \$17 per run per day. (Includes AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry per dog per day. Fees are to be collected by the show -giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.)

Express Mail entries *must* include signature permitting them to be left without recipient signature.

Online Entries / Credit Card Entry

This trial is accepting online entries through **LabTestedOnline.com**.

Online Entries will receive a confirming email from LabTestedOnline which will be considered the initial entry confirmation. All changes to online entries before closing **MUST** be done through the online entry website to ensure that payment is correct. Final confirmation will be received from the Trial Secretary at closing.

PLEASE MAKE YOUR ENTRIES LEGIBLE. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards **do not** constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. (Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.)

Due to the cost of processing, over-payments of \$5 or less will be donated to Sheltie Rescue.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Crating/Parking Information:

RV Parking will be allowed. See accommodation section for more information.

All competitors must park on the grass in designated areas ONLY.

The site is a Christmas tree farm. **Do NOT allow your dogs to relieve themselves on the Christmas trees!**

The road to the agility site is a single-lane driveway with a speed limit of 15 miles per hour. **Please go SLOWLY and watch for on-coming vehicles.**

Food will not be available onsite. There is a restaurant and convenience store 2 miles away.

Crate aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned in heavy traffic areas. This will be strictly enforced. If complaints are received, dogs will be moved.

Smokers, please be considerate and pick up your cigarette butts.

Puppies under 4 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Dogs MAY NOT be left overnight. The Shetland Sheepdog Club of Greater Baltimore will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$7.50 with your entry. A very limited number of catalogs will be available for sale on the show date at a cost of \$10.00.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
