The Covid-19 pandemic is an ever-changing situation. It is our wish to make sure all in attendance stay safe and every precaution will be taken. Exhibitors are expected to follow state, local government, event and facility guidelines.

IMPORTANT:

If you are exhibiting signs of illness or have been otherwise told to self-quarantine due to known COVID-19 exposure, please stay home.

Crating/Setup: FISC is full-occupancy. **CRATING WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUILDING.** As always, crating space is limited, and you should use your best judgment in maintaining a comfortable distance. Crates will have priority. Floor covering required under all crates. Water ONLY in the arena. We will NOT have to remove crates on Friday PM. 😊

The building will be open to agility exhibitors each day at 7:00 a.m. Please note that although the doors are sometimes open earlier for other activities in the building, the club needs to complete ring and equipment set-up before exhibitors will be allowed on the field. NO SET-UPS or site accessibility on Thursday evening.

Crating space on the field is limited. The space on the right wall as you enter the ring is reserved for trial committee. If there is insufficient space, you will be asked to remove chairs from the crating area. No tables on the field floor unless they are over crates. There is additional crating available upstairs. **The Event Committee may limit or move an exhibitor's crating area if it is in the best interests of the trial.**

We will be using the field on the right of the building as you enter – the one normally used for agility.

Masks: The mask-wearing policy is ever-changing. As of the publishing of this judging schedule, masks are not required indoors for fully vaccinated exhibitors. If the policy changes, an email update will be sent to exhibitors. As always, use good judgement in distance when interacting with judge, secretary, volunteers, host club members and other exhibitors.

Course maps: Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be posted on the website of the trial secretary (www.clantyre.net) no earlier than 9:00 PM each evening, sent to exhibitors via email (if I have good wifi access) and available on the Agility Gate app. One copy will be posted if you did not receive them another way. Come prepared to photograph the map for personal use.

Check-in – We will be using the Agility Gate App! THE TRIAL CODE IS: 1689

- Download the Agility Gate app, which is available on the Apple iOS App Store and on Google Play for Android. You will need an internet connection to install and use the app.
- After you launch the app, you'll be presented with a screen. Press the button in the top left corner that looks like three horizontal lines to choose the club/event you want to follow.
- Find the class you want to follow, click on it to open the running order for that particular class.
- You will be asked for the code for the trial. You should only need to do this once. **The trial code is: 1689**
- After picking a class, you will be presented with the running order for the class you chose. Running order is broken up by height and only displays the information for the specific class that you are watching.
- If you place your finger on a row in the running order and swipe towards the left, you will reveal four buttons that you can use to update your dog's status: Check-in, Scratch, FEO or Conflict. Pick the option that best matches your dog's status. You can always swipe to the left to reveal the buttons again and change your dog's status later.
- The running order will update automatically as dogs are checked in, when they run, etc. Keep an eye on the running order to see when you are due up.
- **You should be in the building ready to run 6-10 dogs before your turn. There will be plenty of space in the arena to social distance while waiting in line.**

Check-in: Regular paper gate sheets will also be available for check in.

Official Measurements: We will have a VMO present at this trial. Official measurement will begin on Friday at 7:30 a.m., Saturday and Sunday at 7:15 a.m. Additional measuring time will be provided (as available) as courses are being set. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Reminder: All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card, should they be asked, upon request.

Move ups for the August 13 trial must be received by 6 p.m. on Monday, August 9 (no exceptions).

Move-ups for Friday-Saturday or Saturday-Sunday will be allowed. The move-up book will be located at the secretary's table near the score monitors. Just fill out your move-up form and leave it in the book. Magically, your move-up will happen overnight. ☺ **Please be kind to your trial secretary and make your move-up soon after you finish running the class where you received your new title. I process move-ups throughout the day. The deadline for move-up is 30 minutes after the last run of the day. Move-ups must be made on-site, emails will not be accepted.**

Directions: The **Frederick Indoor Sports Center** is located at 1845 Brookfield Ct., Frederick, MD 21701.

From Route 70, merge onto US-40 toward US-15 N/Gettysburg (US-40 becomes US-15 N). Merge onto MD-26 E/Liberty Rd. via Exit 17 toward MD-194/Libertytown/Walkersville. Take the 1st right onto Routzahns Way/MD-355. Take 1st right onto Wormans Mill Ct. Take the 1st left onto Brookfield Ct. FISC is on the right.

Food will be available at the onsite restaurant.

We wish to thank all those who have volunteered to help at this trial. Any and all assistance makes for a smoother running trial, so please check with the volunteer coordinator often to see how you can help! Volunteers will receive a coupon for each class worked that can be used for future entries or at the Restaurant located inside the facility. **Volunteering just got easier!** The Volunteer sheet will be posted at the trial site each day. You can go in and fill in your name where you would like to work, with our thanks!

Parking - Special Instructions

The parking map below clearly outlines available parking. **Do not park in the parking areas of the businesses directly across from the Sports Center. You WILL be towed.**

The parking map below outlines available parking. The facility marks spaces that are used for their tenants and employees, so please be sure to respect those signs.

Building Access: The large front doors are available for entrance and exit. There is another entrance on the left of the building that is near the parking labeled "PARKING" on the map.

Motorhome Parking: Parking for motorhomes is available at the show site (in the area marked "Overflow Parking"). No reservation is required. Your cooperation is appreciated. **Sometimes, there is a locked gate at the entrance to the Overflow Parking Area. The combination is available at the front desk of FISC, and they are normally open until 11:00 PM.**
