COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an *earlier* group to insure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by MAD Agility.

All classes will take place indoors on field "Sprinturf" surface. Ring size will be 80' x 110'. Electronic timers will be used.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

- First Place.....Blue
- Second Place.....Red
- Third Place.....Yellow
- Fourth Place.....White
- Qualifying Score.....Dark Green Ribbon

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.

(Including MX, MXJ, MXP, MJP and double-Q ribbons)

Dogs earning a MACH or PACH title will receive a ribbon and bar.

"AFTER CLOSING" WAITING LIST

WCWDCA is offering a **Wait List** to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. Any entries that are withdrawn by Monday, July 14, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, July 14, 2014 will receive a full refund.

MOVE-UP INFORMATION

Move-ups must be sent in writing to the Trial Secretary for the Friday trial no later than the Monday preceding the trial at 6 p.m. These may be faxed, mailed or e-mailed. **Day-to-day move ups will be allowed between the trial dates and must be submitted in person to the Trial Secretary by the end of judging each day.**

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

This trial will not offer entries for All-American Dogs/Mixed Breeds.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Confirmation of entry, move-up or cancellation will be sent via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. (It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their e-mail address is legible and that messages will be accepted from agilitysec@clantyre.net.)

Entries open May 19, 2014 (8 a.m.) at the Trial Secretary's address and will be limited to 400 runs per day. The method of entry is **Random Draw**. Entries for the random draw will be taken between May 19, 2014 at 8:00 a.m. and June 10, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. The drawing, if necessary, will be held on June 11, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at the address of the Trial Secretary, 5474 Delphinium Ct., Columbia, MD 21045. The closing date is July 2, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary.

Entry fees are \$20.00 per run (per dog) each day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee for the first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry). Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. (Agility fax/credit card entries are accepted under the rules of "first received," and cannot be processed in the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.) Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (**Visa, MasterCard or Discover**) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$4.00 per dog. (Trials may not be combined.) All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. PLEASE MAKE YOUR ENTRIES LEGIBLE. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards **do not** constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. (Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.)

Due to the cost of processing, over-payments of \$5 or less will not be processed.

Express Mail entries *must* include signature permitting them to be left without recipient signature.

NOTE: WORKERS' DRAW LIST

Due to the Random Draw entry method, worker spaces will be held for a limited number of handlers by the Event Committee. Those who wish to be considered for the workers' draw list must agree to work 2 or more classes each day of the trial they have entered. If you are willing to be on the worker list, please check the worker box on the entry form.

Snacks & drinks will be provided for all workers.
Additionally, a \$5 voucher will be given each day to volunteers for each 2 classes worked.
It can be used at the snack bar or turned in for \$5 cash.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Crating and Set-up Information:

Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. High occupancy ex-pens (3 dogs or more) ONLY.

No set-up time available on Thursday evening. The building will not be available until Friday morning. Set-up will be allowed after the ring has been set. Those exhibitors who come in and help with equipment set-up will be given priority at crating set-up time ☺

Crating will be allowed in the ring on Friday, but must be removed at the end of the day.

Since crating space is limited, unentered dogs may be asked to leave the crating area.

Crate aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned on the corners of aisles or other heavy traffic areas. This will be strictly enforced. If complaints are received, dogs will be moved.

Puppies under 4 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds, and will be excused from the crating area. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave the crating area.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund 50% of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. All requests must be received prior to the start of judging on Friday.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. WCWDCA and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

This club does NOT agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Dogs MAY NOT be left overnight. The Weimaraner Club of the Washington DC Area will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Motorhomes requiring a spot larger than a standard 7' x 18' space must be parked in the Lower lot. (*Strictly enforced.*) Overnight parking is allowed in the Lower lot only, with reservation (see Motorhome Information.)

A very limited number of catalogs will be available for sale on the show date at a cost of \$15.00.
