Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Dogs in the Preferred class MUST run in their proper height class.

Measuring and Height Card Information

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog has a valid jump height card or if their dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

③

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Breeds not registerable with the AKC are not eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

This trial will not offer entries for All-American Dogs/Mixed Breeds.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility. Equipment provided by MAD Agility, who will be providing **24"** weave poles.

All classes will take place indoors on field turf surface. Ring size will be 100' x 100'. Electronic timers will be used.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulations agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Ribbons & Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class.

First Place Blue
Second Place . . . Red
Third Place . . . Yellow
Fourth Place . . White
Qualifying Score Dark Green

A new-title rosette will be offered to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.

A MACH rosette and MACH bar will be awarded to teams that attain their MACH.

A PAX rosette will be awarded to teams that attain their PAX

NOTE: Workers' Draw List

Due to the Random Draw Entry method, worker spaces will be held for a limited number of handlers by the event committee. Those who wish to be considered for the workers' draw list must agree to work <u>2 or more classes</u> each day of the trial they have entered. If you are willing to be on the worker list, please fill out the Volunteer form, noting what you would like to do.

Entry Information

- Entries open Tuesday, March 15, 2011 (8 a.m.) at the Trial Secretary's address and will be limited to 330 runs per day. The method of entry is Random Draw. Entries for the Random Draw will be taken between Tuesday, March 15, 2011 at 8:00 a.m. and Tuesday, April 12, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. The drawing, if necessary, will be held on April 13, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at the address of the Trial Secretary, 5474 Delphinium Ct., Columbia, MD 21045. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. Entries close Thursday, May 5, 2011 at 6 p.m.
- Entry fees are \$19 per run per day. (Each entry fee, each day includes \$3 AKC recording fee. Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.) Make checks payable (in US funds) to Weimaraner Club of the Washington DC Area (or WCWDCA).
- Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. (Agility fax/credit card entries are accepted under the rules of "first received." If the trial is "first received," the entry cannot be processed in the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.) Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (Visa or MasterCard) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$3.50 per <u>dog</u>. All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. Notice To Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The building will NOT be available for set-up on Thursday evening.
- Puppies under 6 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds, and will be excused from the crating area.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund all but \$5.00 dollars per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason.

Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. Notes must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than the Wednesday following the trial.

- WCWDCA is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. Any entries that are withdrawn by Sunday, May 15, 2011 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sunday, May 15, 2011 will receive a full refund.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. WCWDCA and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Crate aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned on the corners of aisles or other heavy traffic areas. This will be enforced and if complaints are received, dogs will be moved.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Dogs MAY NOT be left overnight. The WCWDCA will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$15.00 with your entry. A very limited number of catalogs will be available for sale on the show date.
- Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. High-occupancy (3 dogs or more) ex-pens only.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes <u>must</u> compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
