Here's how it works!

Weimaraners entering on Saturday, May 16 must enter the Weimaraner Club of America's National Specialty Agility Trial, which is embedded within the WCWDCA trial. Use the WCA entry form to enter Saturday. Use the WCWDCA entry form to enter Friday and Sunday.

Embedding the WCA National Specialty agility trial gives the clubs an opportunity to award placements to Weimaraners during their National Specialty and the WCWDCA to still welcome all other breeds to their normal event.

All Other Breeds/Canine Partners: Enter as normal! All three days of the WCWDCA agility trial is open to all AKC breeds and All-American Dogs/Mixed Breed dogs. Because it's their National Specialty week, the Weimaraners are getting a 10-day "preferred" opening period. The event has expanded to two judges on Saturday and Sunday to give extra room in the trial. The trial has not classically filled with Weimaraner entry, so send your entry in as normal on opening day.

AKC Class Changes, Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day: Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG): As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program and must be spayed or neutered in order to participate. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by MAD Agility Equipment. Electronic timers will be used.

All classes will take place indoors on field turf surface. Ring size will be 80 x 110.

Course Walk-throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an "earlier" group to insure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Ribbons, Awards and Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue
Second Place.....Red
Third Place.....Yellow
Fourth Place.....White
Qualifying Score.....Dark Green Ribbon

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.
Dogs earning a MACH or PACH title will receive a ribbon and bar.

Move-Up Information

Per Chapter 1, Section 20, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials.

Move-ups may be e-mailed, mailed or faxed. Verbal move ups will not be accepted. Please include basic (legible) information: Owner's name, dog's registered name and call name, registration number, class change information. Confirmation of move-up will be sent via e-mail. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately.

Day-to-day move ups will be allowed between the trial dates and will be taken up to one-half hour after the conclusion of the last class each day. These move-ups must be submitted in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary.

Refund Policy

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund 50% of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season. Full refund will be made for deceased dogs provided notification is made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial. No vet note required.

Clubs must list in the premium all situations for which they will provide a refund (see first paragraph). Refunds will not be made for any circumstance other than those listed. This includes but is not limited to injured handlers, death in the family, other owner/handler emergencies. Clubs/Trial Chairs/Trial Secretaries cannot make exceptions or honor refund requests for situations not listed. (AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 9.)

*All veterinarian notes must be signed, dated after the closing date, on official business letterhead and presented to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial. After that time, refund requests will not be accepted. Please note: Phone calls, "text only" emails and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. Vet notes may not be written by owner, handler or immediate family member.

Entry Information

Confirmation of entry, move-up or cancellation will be sent via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline or entry cancellation by the closing date/time, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their e-mail address is legible and that messages will be accepted from agilitysec@clantyre.net.

Entry method is First Received. Entries open March 6, 2020 (8 a.m.) at the Trial Secretary's address and will be limited to 350 runs on Friday, 425 runs on Saturday and 400 runs on Sunday. The closing date is May 1, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.

Entry fees are \$20.00 per run per day. (Includes AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry per dog per day. Fees are to be collected by the show-going club and paid to the American Kennel Club.)

Junior Handler discounted fees: \$10 per run per day. Junior Handler name and AKC JH number must be included on the entry form. Dogs must be run by the Junior Handler listed on the form. If the dog is run by a handler other than the entered Junior, the regular entry fee must be paid to the Secretary prior to the dog's run.

Express Mail entries *must* include signature permitting them to be left without recipient signature.

Online / Credit Card Entries

This trial is accepting online entries through **LabTestedOnline.com**.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: Forty percent (40%) of entries per day available for online entry, sixty percent (60%) of entries per day for paper entries. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Online Entries will receive a confirming email from LabTestedOnline which will be considered the initial entry confirmation. All changes to online entries before closing **MUST** be done through the online entry website to ensure that payment is correct. Final confirmation will be received from the Trial Secretary at closing.

PLEASE MAKE YOUR ENTRIES LEGIBLE. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards **do not** constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. (Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.)

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Crating and Set-up Information:

Waterproof cloth or tarps must be placed underneath crates. High-occupancy (3 dogs or more) ex-pens **ONLY**.

The terms of the facility contract make it necessary for us to completely clear the ring after the end of the Friday trial (ONLY) for other scheduled events on Friday evening. ALL crates, chairs, etc. must be removed. We will not have to clear the ring after the Saturday trial.

Crating space is limited, so plan on getting cozy with your neighbor and sharing where you can. There is additional crating space upstairs. Due to space limitations, unentered dogs may be asked to leave.

There is no set-up available on Thursday evening.

Crate aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned on the corners of aisles or other heavy traffic areas. This will be strictly enforced. If complaints are received, dogs will be moved.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. WCWDCA is not responsible for the behavior of the attendees or their dogs. If attendees' dogs create an unsafe situation for other attendees or their dogs, the owners of misbehaving dogs remain liable for any damages and may be asked to leave. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. WCWDCA and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

This club does NOT agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Dogs **MAY NOT** be left overnight. The Weimaraner Club of the Washington DC Area will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$10.00 with your entry. A very limited number of catalogs will be available for sale on the show date at a cost of \$12.00.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.
