#### COVID-19 "Stuff" – Policies, Restrictions and Whatnot:

The Covid-19 pandemic is an ever-changing situation. It is our wish to make sure all in attendance stay safe and every precaution will be taken, and we depend upon your cooperation to make it work! IMPORTANT: If you are exhibiting signs of illness or have been otherwise told to self-quarantine due to known COVID-19 exposure, please stay home.

- <u>Crating</u> will be allowed inside the building. There is plenty of room! Crating will be allowed on the field to the left and the basketball court. Crates will <u>not</u> be allowed on the agility field chairs ONLY. Take your chair with you each evening we must clear the field for a soccer event in the evening. Crates will not have to be broken down or moved during the weekend.
- At this time, we do not expect <u>masks</u> to be required in the building. However, the COVID situation is ever changing, and we will follow the facility, state and local mandates at the time of the trial. Signs will be posted if anything changes. Please come prepared with a mask just in case.
- You may run with your leash in your pocket (must fit fully) or wear them while running the course. Don't drop it!

#### • And now, the regular stuff:

<u>Course maps</u>: Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be sent to exhibitors via email each morning. (I will make every effort to send around 6:00 AM.) NOTE: AKC is no longer allowing course maps to be provided the evening before the trial. They will be posted at the trial site, as well, so come prepared to photograph the map for personal use.

Briefings/walkthroughs: See judging schedule page for briefing/walkthrough schedule.

<u>Check-in:</u> Regular paper gate sheets will be available for check in. (We are not using an electronic check-in system.) Any changes in running order must be done by the Gate Steward for the class.

<u>Measuring</u>: No measurements will be done at this trial. We will <u>not</u> have a VMO in attendance, and the judge of record will <u>not</u> measure dogs (AKC's COVID-19 policy). Reminder: All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial.

Move ups for the May 20 trial must be received by 6 p.m. on Monday, May 16. Move-ups for Friday-Saturday or Saturday-Sunday will be allowed and must be submitted within ½ hour of the end of judging each day. The move-up book will be located on the table . Just fill out your move-up form and leave it in the book. Magically, your move-up will happen overnight. ©

Parking: There is plenty of parking. RV parking is by reservation only (see premium for details).

<u>Crating/setup</u>: The building will open at 6:45 AM each morning. NO SET-UPS or site accessibility on Thursday evening. Friday Morning: Folks who are willing to help move the equipment from the storage location to the ring can come in at 6:15 AM and drop their tarp.

Food and refreshments will be available at the trial site at the on-site restaurant.

Recording/videoing for personal use is not prohibited as long as it does not obstruct aisles/walkways, disturb other exhibitors, dogs, or judge(s). Those using video must be cognizant of both intentional and ambient audio. These devices may not be used near the trial secretary/judge/club working areas or placed behind timer/scribe working in the ring.

We wish to thank all those who have volunteered to help at this trial. Any and all assistance makes for a smoother running trial, so please check with the volunteer coordinator in each ring often to see how you can help! Volunteering just got easier! The Volunteer boards will be posted near the ring at the trial site each day. You can go in and fill in your name where you'd like to work, with our thanks!

Volunteer coupons will be given for each class worked, good towards food purchase at the on-site restaurant or applied towards future entries.

Remember! Keep the area clean! As always, exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up any deposits left by their dog. Any exhibitor failing to pick up after their dog will be EXCUSED without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor is in violation of this requirement. While the use of flexi-leads is not prohibited on show grounds, we urge you to use them responsibly. Failure to properly control a dog at an event can be grounds for a misconduct hearing. Let's keep this site dog friendly!

From **Baltimore**: From Baltimore Beltway (I-695) take Exit 19, Northwest Expressway (I-795) towards Owings Mills/Reisterstown. Continue until the Expressway ends, bear right onto Route 140 West. Follow 140 West for approx. 10 miles, turn left onto Route 97 (Weis Market on right, PetSmart market on the left.) At the 2<sup>nd</sup> light, turn Left onto Old Westminster Pike. The Carroll Indoor Sports Center will be on the right a short distance after the turn.

From **DC & Virginia:** From DC Beltway (I-495) take I-270 exit towards Frederick. From 270, take Damascus exit (Route 27 North). Stay on 27 North approx. 25 miles to Main Street in Westminster. Turn right onto Main Street. Go 1.5 miles. C.I.S.C. will be on right side of road after crossing over Route 97.
