RUNNING ORDER / Move-Ups

Tests will all be in running order. If you are late to the Gate Steward and miss your scheduled test, you will be moved to the end of the order. You will not be counted as absent until the testing judge has given opportunity to all present with the Gate Steward to test their dogs.

There is no guarantee that dogs entered in IQ will run that class before their regular class test.

Once a class has been concluded, any dog not present will be counted as absent. The Test Committee reserves the right to modify the test running order to keep the events running smoothly.

MOVE UPS: All move up requests must be submitted in writing and received by the Test Secretary no later than 8:30 AM on the day of the test.

ME braces will be drawn 15 minutes before the class start time.
All Master Earthdog Entries MUST check in by 8:00 a.m.

Site is on the right approximately 0.3 miles.
