ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS

Dogs may enter only one regular class at an Earthdog test, except dogs which have earned a Master Earthdog title may enter more than one regular class.

Master Earthdog is open only to dogs that have acquired the Senior Earthdog title before entries have closed or have been awarded the Master Earthdog title.

Senior Earthdog is open only to dogs that have acquired the Junior Earthdog title before the entries have closed and to dogs with Master or Senior Earthdog titles.

Junior Earthdog class is open to dogs that have not been recorded as or received qualifying scores in Senior Earthdog or Master Earthdog and to dogs that have acquired a Master Earthdog title.
