Eligibility of Dogs

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. For more information on eligibility, check www.akc.org. Females in season may not run.

Notice to Exhibitors

- All dogs run at owner's sole risk.
- Dogs must be one year of age or older the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form in which it is entered. Bitches in season and lame
 dogs will be refused entry and if presented at inspection, entry fee will not be refunded. Spayed
 or neutered dogs may be entered.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "agreement" found on an official AKC entry form.
- Dogs that are overweight or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury or exhaustion. The
 inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry. In this case the entry fee will
 not be refunded.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations and ensure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations. You may be asked for proof of rabies, please bring the certificate.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, a public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the club or its members or representatives.
- Battery powered continuous loop machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips.
 Only the Lure Operator, Hunt Master, Judge and handlers of the hounds running in the course in progress will be near the lure machine. The members of the ABMC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the test by the Field Committee and my be disciplined by AKC. Children must be under control of their parent (s) or guardian(s) at all times.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed on the owner or handler of any dog loose on the field not competing in the course in progress.

The Coursing Ability Test is an introductory event fashioned after the sport of lure coursing. It will provide a fun and healthy activity attractive to many dog owners. The following is a summary of how the event is structured:

This is a non-competitive pass/fail event fashioned after the sport of lure coursing.

Dogs run singularly.

An inspection committee shall inspect each entry for lameness, fitness to compete and females in season.

Course Distance/Design


- Dogs under 12" at the withers and/or flat-faced dogs will run approximately 300 yards.
- Dogs over 12" at the withers and not flat-faced will run approximately 600 yards.
- Veteran dogs, 7 years of age and older will run approximately 300 yards.

If there is a question whether a dog should run 300 or 600 yards, the judge will decide.

The course will be basically rectangular in shape with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. Safety is of utmost importance. Since many of the dogs running will not be as agile as a sighthound, this must be a consideration in the design of the course.

Pass: the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within a maximum amount of time. Max times: 600 yards-2minutes; 300 yards-1 1.2 minutes. The maximum time is not meant to be difficult to achieve. It is meant to prevent a dog that "walks" the course from passing.

The fields are fenced with typical farm fencing, and regularly contain sheep and cattle. The field is not smooth and flat..

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable. Please include legible e-mail address on your entry form.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. Event Service Fees on herding events will be \$3.50 per entry. (American Kennel Club Herding Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.)

Credit Card Entries

Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time via PayPal.

Entry forms may be scanned and emailed to clantyre.showsec@gmail.com or faxed to 410-997-7918. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. Once received, a PayPal invoice will be generated and sent to the exhibitor as soon as practicable. Payments must be received by closing, so please plan accordingly.

Keepstone Farm is located at 412 Russell Road, in scenic Berryville, Virginia; less than a mile from Route 7 West. It is easily accessible from Northern Virginia, West Virginia and Frederick Maryland via major roadways.

<u>From the East:</u> From Leesburg VA, take Route 7 West. Passing 2 traffic lights after the Rt 340 exit for Berryville, turn Right on Russell Road (Rt 660).

* Go 3/10 mile, turn Right at large Keepstone Farm sign (Dog Gone Healthy sign below). Follow farm lane to Left turn at #412, and go to end of Driveway.

<u>From the West:</u> From I-81, Take Exit 315, Rt 7 East at Winchester VA. Go about 6 miles, and turn Left on Russell Road (Rt 660). Follow * directions above.

<u>From the North:</u> From Frederick MD, take Rt 340/15 South, bearing right on 340 South at the split. Follow 340 to Charles Town WV, and continue South on 340 to Rt 7 West at Berryville VA. Follow Rt 7 West through 2 traffic lights, to Russell Rd on right. Follow ** directions above.

<u>From the South:</u> From Rt 66 West - Take Rt 17 North toward Paris VA. Take 17 to traffic light, and turn Left onto Rt 50 West toward Winchester. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the
 particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not
 exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies
 (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat,
 long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature,
 standard).
- 2. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
