Notice To Exhibitors

Entries for <u>Conformation</u>, <u>Obedience</u>, <u>Rally</u>, <u>Agility</u>, <u>Scent Work and Herding</u> close at 6:00 PM, **Wednesday**, **April 22**, **2020**, <u>Tracking</u> closes **May 1**, **2020 at 5:00 PM** at Trial Secretary's address after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable. Please include legible e-mail address on your entry form.

Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery.

Postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. Event Service Fees on herding events will be \$3.50 per entry. (American Kennel Club Herding Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.)

The Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

AKC Event Service and Recording Fees are detailed under the section for each venue.

If offered, refund policies are described under the section for each venue. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.) No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award

Qualifications for Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award:

Dogs must participate and earn points in at least three of the following five venues: Agility (Sunday, May 10), Conformation (Thursday, May 14 National Specialty/Sweepstakes), Obedience or Rally - Regular or Optional Titling Classes only (Wednesday, May 13) Herding Trial 2 (Tuesday, May 12, Malinois only trial), Tracking or Scent Work Trial 2 (Monday, May 11).

A dog may be entered in more than 3 venues. The single highest point value earned in each venue will be used in tabulating the points earned for that venue. The dog with the highest combined total score for all venues will be awarded Most Versatile Belgian Malinois. Reserve Most Versatile Malinois will be awarded to the second place finisher. Membership in the ABMC is not required. However, the dog being entered must be a Belgian Malinois. For further information, point scale and entry form, visit the Specialty website. The MVBMA Chair will track the results based on the Show/Trial Secretary information and points for each dog entered will be posted daily. The Award will be presented at the National Banquet on Thursday, May 14.. The winner of the award need not be present to win.

Classes Offered & Proposed Running Order

Judging begins at 8:00 AM each day.

Classes will be run Tall-Small each day in the following order:

Time2Beat, Standard (Master/Excellent/Open/Novice), JWW (Master/Excellent/Open/Novice)

Measuring and Height Card Information

Exhibitors are not required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. A copy of the jump height card is not required to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/ wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partner Listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at http://www.akc.org/rules.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by MAD Agility. Phone: (717) 543-5693

All classes will take place indoors on Sportsturf. The ring size will be 110' x 76'.

Electronic timers will be used

Course Walk-throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an *earlier* group to insure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

After Closing Waiting List

A post-closing waiting list is not offered for this trial. Any exhibitor that wishes to withdraw must do so before the published closing date and time.

A rosette will be offered to <u>all</u> dog/handler teams finishing a title.

A rosette and bar will be offered to dog/handler teams who finish their MACH or PACH.

A ribbon will be given for a perfect score not earned in the Master classes.

A ribbon will be given for a double-Q earned from the Master class.

Belgian Malinois High in Trial and High Combined Award

On Sunday only, ABMC will award a rosette for High In Trial Malinois and High Combined Malinois for both the Regular classes and Preferred classes. HIT will be calculated by Double Q and then fastest yps by those dogs in the Master Classes. High Combined will be calculated as follows: only scores of 100 in Standard and JWW will count. Novice dogs will be given 1 point per qualifying run, Open dogs will be given 1.5 points, and Master/Excellent dogs will be given 2 points. An extra point will be given to any dog who qualifies in both runs. A tie will be broken by fastest yps.

AKC Class Changes, Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Refund Policy

If the limit for entries is not reached in one test at a combined TDU-VST test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged, up to the day of plotting.

ENTRIES will be acknowledged with a judging program after the closing date. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

ENTRY FEES for alternates who don't participate in the test will be refunded within one week of the completion of the test. Entry fees for dogs which pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test will be refunded if they withdraw from this test provided there is an alternate to replace the entry and the Test Secretary is notified in writing not less than 3 days before the test date. Bitches in season may participate (Ch. 2, Sec. 8). Other AKC recognized breeds, in addition to Belgian Malinois may participate (Ch.1, Sec. 13).

No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within thirty (30) days prior to the date of the event (Chapter 1, Sec. 12).

People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 30 days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler (Chapter 2, Sec. 9).

If the entries received exceed the published class limit, a public drawing for entries and alternates will be held on Friday, May 1, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the address of the test secretary: 2108 Allen Road, Berryville, VA 22611. All interested may attend. The drawing of entries will be executed in accordance with Ch. 1, Sec. 17 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

Tracking Test Site Information

 long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature,
 standard).
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
