Notice to Exhibitors

As of this printing, the weather looks promising, however, BRHA reserves the right to make trial day adjustments based on weather and field conditions. The most up to date information will be available on BRHA's Facebook page: www.facebook.com/blueridgeherding

- Bitches in season shall be eligible and will be run in order in the trial classes, and will be run at the end of their class in test classes.
- Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Bring shade, water and chair. Event will be held rain, shine, or snow.
- All dogs present which are not being worked in the arena must be kept quiet, off course, on leash and away from the fences. Please do not allow them to disturb the resting stock or interfere with the working dog.
- PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. Every effort has been made to resolve conflicts. **Daylight hours are limited, please be at the gate at least one dog before your run to ensure a timely trial.**

**** JUDGE CHANGE NOTICE ****

Because of the awesome entry this trial had, we have shifted the herding instinct test class to the opposite judge than was listed in the judging schedule. Leida Jones will be judging the instinct test classes on Saturday, and Leila Jane Bradley will be judging them on Sunday.

Per Chapter II of the Herding regulations, "A handler, who has been notified in advance with a dog entered under the substitute judge may withdraw the entry of that dog and shall be entitled to a refund of the entry fee if the dog is withdrawn prior to the commencement of the trial."

Please let me know ASAP if you will be unable to trial under the substitute judge. This only applies to entries in the affected classes.

Move-Ups & Alternates

Requests to move up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. Alternates must check in with the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their level. Within the test levels, alternate entries shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved up. Within the trial levels, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries. Alternates will be permitted to run if there is an absentee in an earlier level which was not filled on the same course, same type of livestock, and under the same judge, or if a dog has been marked absent with the trial secretary prior to the beginning of the alternate's level. (*Chapter 1, Section 13, AKC Herding Regulations*)

Directions

Keepstone Farm is located at 412 Russell Road, at Keepstone Farm in scenic Berryville, Virginia; less than a mile from Route 7 West. It is easily accessible from Northern Virginia, West Virginia and Frederick Maryland via major roadways.

From the East: From Leesburg VA, take Route 7 West. Passing 2 traffic lights after the Rt 340 exit for Berryville, turn Right on Russell Road (Rt 660).

* Go 3/10 mile, turn Right at large Keepstone Farm sign (Dog Gone Healthy sign below). Follow farm lane to Left turn at #412, and go to end of Driveway.

From the West: From I-81, Take Exit 315, Rt 7 East at Winchester VA. Go about 6 miles, and turn Left on Russell Road (Rt 660). Follow * directions above.

From the North: From Frederick MD, take Rt 340/15 South, bearing right on 340 South at the split. Follow 340 to Charles Town WV, and continue South on 340 to Rt 7 West at Berryville VA. Follow Rt 7 West through 2 traffic lights, to Russell Rd on right. Follow * directions above.

From the South: From Rt 66 West - Take Rt 17 North toward Paris VA. Take 17 to traffic light, and turn Left onto Rt 50 West toward Winchester. Follow Rt 50 W to a Right turn at Rt 340 North. (Sheetz Station at light). After going through the towns of Boyce and Berryville, turn Left onto Rt 7 West. Follow * directions above.
