Eligibility of Dogs

<u>Trial levels, HT and PT</u> are open to all herding breeds nine (9) months of age or older that are registered with The American Kennel Club or have been granted an ILP\PAL and are eligible to compete in herding trials and tests under Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC Herding Regulations.

The Herding Instinct Test is open to all herding breeds six (6) months of age or older that are registered with The American Kennel Club or have been granted an ILP\PAL and are eligible to compete in herding trials and tests under Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC Herding Regulations.

Notice to Exhibitors

- Bitches in season shall be eligible and will be run at the end of their level in tests, in catalog order at the trial level.
- There will be no smoking at the show site. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Bring shade, water and chair. Event will be held rain or shine.
- All dogs present which are not being worked in the arena must be kept quiet, off course, on leash and away from the fences. Please do not allow them to disturb the resting stock or interfere with the working dog.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- Exhibition Only and Instinct Test Day-of entries will be offered if entries have not reached the numerical limits.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Keepstone Farm, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Closing of Entries/Alternates and Move-Ups

Directions

Keepstone Farm is located at 412 Russell Road, in scenic Berryville, Virginia; less than a mile from Route 7 West. It is easily accessible from Northern Virginia, West Virginia and Frederick Maryland via major roadways.

<u>From the East:</u> From Leesburg VA, take Route 7 West. Passing 2 traffic lights after the Rt 340 exit for Berryville, turn Right on Russell Road (Rt 660).

* Go 3/10 mile, turn Right at large Keepstone Farm sign (Dog Gone Healthy sign below). Follow farm lane to Left turn at #412, and go to end of Driveway.

<u>From the West:</u> From I-81, Take Exit 315, Rt 7 East at Winchester VA. Go about 6 miles, and turn Left on Russell Road (Rt 660). Follow * directions above.

<u>From the North:</u> From Frederick MD, take Rt 340/15 South, bearing right on 340 South at the split. Follow 340 to Charles Town WV, and continue South on 340 to Rt 7 West at Berryville VA. Follow Rt 7 West through 2 traffic lights, to Russell Rd on right. Follow ** directions above.

<u>From the South:</u> From Rt 66 West - Take Rt 17 North toward Paris VA. Take 17 to traffic light, and turn Left onto Rt 50 West toward Winchester. Follow Rt 50 W to a Right turn at Rt 340 North (Sheetz Station at light). After going through the towns of Boyce and Berryville, turn Left onto Rt 7 West. Follow * directions above.

Herding Instinct Test

The Instinct Test is held in a small pen, either round in shape or with rounded corners, which can vary in size from 50×50 feet, up to 100×100 feet. Livestock used will be sheep. The dog will enter the pen on a 6-15 foot long line. Before removing the line, the dog must demonstrate a stop (down, sit or stand) and a recall. Once the dog has completed this exercise, the line may be dropped for the dog to drag, or removed entirely. If the dog cannot exhibit the stop, the tester is not to allow the dog off-line.

Once the dog is allowed to approach the livestock, the tester will be looking for sustained interest in controlling the livestock. This can be shown by the dog gathering the livestock, moving the livestock toward the handler, or moving them ahead of the handler in a driving position. A combination of any of these styles is acceptable.

Instinct Tests are open to all dogs six months of age or older, with or without previous experience on stock. Either the owner or the tester can work the dog for the Instinct Test.

The Blue Ridge Herding Association has set this test up so that exhibitors can sign up for two Instinct Tests under two separate judges. Passing dogs can complete the AKC Herding Instinct Certificate requirements in a single day.
