Notice to Exhibitors

BRHA reserves the right to make trial day adjustments based on weather and field conditions. The most up to date information will be available on BRHA's Facebook page: www.facebook.com/blueridgeherding

- Bitches in season shall be eligible and will be run in order in the trial classes, and will be run at the end of their class in test classes.
- Running order: Dogs are assigned the same armband number for the entire weekend, however the run order is staggered for each trial.
- Workers: If you are willing and able to scribe for any classes, please contact Rhonda at agilitysec@clantyre.net to sign up. We feed our workers!
- Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Bring shade, water and chair. Event will be held rain, shine, or snow.
- All dogs present which are not being worked in the arena must be kept quiet, off course, on leash and away from the fences. Please do not allow them to disturb the resting stock or interfere with the working dog.
- Please note: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. Every effort has been made to resolve conflicts. **Daylight hours are limited, please be at the gate at least one dog before your run to ensure a timely trial.**

Move-Ups & Alternates

Requests to move up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. Within the test levels, alternate entries shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved up. Within the trial levels, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries. Because of the set-up for this event, trial to trial move-ups are not available on the same day. Dogs can be moved from Saturday to Sunday, but not from Trial 1 to Trial 2 (or vice versa) on the same day.

Directions

Keepstone Farm is located at 412 Russell Road, at Keepstone Farm in scenic Berryville, Virginia; less than a mile from Route 7 West. It is easily accessible from Northern Virginia, West Virginia and Frederick Maryland via major roadways.

From the East: From Leesburg VA, take Route 7 West. Passing 2 traffic lights after the Rt 340 exit for Berryville, turn Right on Russell Road (Rt 660).

* Go 3/10 mile, turn Right at large Keepstone Farm sign (Dog Gone Healthy sign below). Follow farm lane to Left turn at #412, and go to end of Driveway.

From the West: From I-81, Take Exit 315, Rt 7 East at Winchester VA. Go about 6 miles, and turn Left on Russell Road (Rt 660). Follow * directions above.

From the North: From Frederick MD, take Rt 340/15 South, bearing right on 340 South at the split. Follow 340 to Charles Town WV, and continue South on 340 to Rt 7 West at Berryville VA. Follow Rt 7 West through 2 traffic lights, to Russell Rd on right. Follow * directions above.

From the South: From Rt 66 West - Take Rt 17 North toward Paris VA. Take 17 to traffic light, and turn Left onto Rt 50 West toward Winchester. Follow Rt 50 W to a Right turn at Rt 340 North. (Sheetz Station at light). After going through the towns of Boyce and Berryville, turn Left onto Rt 7 West. Follow * directions above.
