Pre-entries close at 6:00 p.m., **Friday, January 18, 2019**Day-of-Show entries will be taken at the show site if the limits are not reached with pre-entered dogs.

The FDC Test is designed to assess the overall conduct of a dog in a typical farm environment. The dog must demonstrate self-control when exposed to livestock and other unique sights, sounds and scents. The dog must exhibit confidence and a willingness to comply with instructions when confronted with a variety of situations. The FDC Test is not intended to confer herding ability, but rather a foundation of self-control and biddability beneficial to all working dogs.

The FDC Test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

Limits and Scheduling

Each event number is limited to 32 entries. If those entries are filled with pre-entered dogs, no day-of-show entries will be accepted.

A sign-in sheet will be available at the check-in table for times. We understand that many people will be entered in the agility trial. To avoid conflicts, it is up to the exhibitor to sign-in and schedule their own times. All testing must be complete within the times stated above. Late arrivals may or may not be accommodated, depending on the schedule.

Eligibility of Dogs

The FDC Test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. This information must be available at the time of testing (for day-of-show entries).

Females in season may not enter. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test.

A dog may enter only once per event. An event is defined by an event number.

Confirmation of entry, move-up or cancellation will be sent via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. If you have not received a confirmation of entry or entry cancellation by the closing date/time, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their e-mail address is legible and that messages will be accepted from clantyre@gmail.com

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable. Please include legible email address on your entry form.

Returned checks or chargebacks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check or chargeback. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. Event Service Fees on herding events will be \$3.50 per entry. (American Kennel Club Herding Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.)

Credit Card Payment

Notice to Exhibitors

Pet Expo — IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This event is being held in conjunction with the Annual World of Pets Expo (www.worldofpets.org). Entry in this test does not include entry to the Pet Expo. The Pet Expo does charge an admission fee separate from this test.

No exhibitors will be allowed in the Pet Expo vendor area when the Pet Expo is not open to the public. Wandering the vendor area when the Pet Expo is not open will be grounds for misconduct and dismissal from the trial.

Directions to the Trial Site

The Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium is located just north of Baltimore and is easily accessible from I-83 (Exit 17).

From Baltimore:

- Follow I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) to I-83 North (Exit 24). North on I-83 approximately 2 miles to Exit 17 (Padonia Rd). Follow signs to Fairgrounds approximately 1.5 miles.
- From the North: I-83 to Exit 17 (Padonia Rd). Follow signs to Fairgrounds approximately 1.5 miles.

- I-83 South to left exit to I-695 East (Baltimore Beltway Inner Loop). Go approximately 4 miles
 to Exit 29A (Cromwell Bridge Road exit). At the end of the exit ramp go straight through the
 light. Go approximately 0.1 miles up a hill and you will see the building in front of you. (It is
 actually on the right of the road.)
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of
 internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate
 vaccinations.

Refund Policy

- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it
 is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.
- Refunds of entries pulled after closing date will be made as long as an alternate is available to replace the run; if no alternate runs, no refund will be given.
- No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the BRHA after the closing date (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6) including injured or sick dogs or handlers. In the event of a spouse, sibling, parent or entered dog's untimely death, an event committee decision will be made.
- Declination of entries: The BRHA may decline any entries for cause and may remove any dog on
 account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse
 against the BRHA or any official thereof. In this case, no refund will be made.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
