Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. Effective January 1, 2008 Event Service Fees on all AKC events will be \$3.50 for the first entry and \$3 for each additional entry in addition to the \$.50 recording fee for the first entry of each dog in Obedience. (*American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2.*)

Fax/Credit Card Entries

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (**Visa, MasterCard or Discover**) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Bitches in season shall be eligible and will be run in order in the trial classes, and will be run at the end of their class in test classes.
- There will be no smoking at the show site. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Bring shade, water and chair. Event will be held rain or shine.
- All dogs present which are not being worked in the arena must be kept quiet, off course, on leash and away from the fences. Please do not allow them to disturb the resting stock or interfere with the working dog.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors, alone, are responsible for the behavior of their dogs/children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- Exhibition Only Day-of entries will be offered if entries have not reached the numerical limits and must be received by the trial secretary by 8:00 a.m.
- **REFUND POLICY:**

1. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

2. No refunds for bitches in season.

3. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

4. Refunds of entries pulled after closing date will be made as long as an alternate is available to replace the run; if no alternate runs, no refund will be given.

5. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the SSCGB after the closing date (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6) including injured or sick dogs or handlers. In the event of a spouse, sibling, parent or entered dog's untimely death, an event committee decision will be made.

Closing of Entries/Alternates and Move-Ups (AKC Herding Rules & Regulations, Section 13):

- Whenever trial entry limits have been reached all additional entries that are received prior to the closing date shall be added to an alternate's list for each level that exceeds the published limit(s). This trial will keep an alternate list of five (5) runs.
- Duck entries: Duck entries are limited to 20 runs per day. A five (5) dog alternate list will be kept for duck entries.
- Entrants on the alternates list must check in with the Herding Secretary on the grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class.
- Entry fee will be refunded to the alternates whose dogs do not have an opportunity to run.
- Requests for move-up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

DIRECTIONS

Keepstone Farm is located at 412 Russell Road, in scenic Berryville, Virginia; less than a mile from Route 7 West. It is easily accessible from Northern Virginia, West Virginia and Frederick Maryland via major roadways.

From the East: From Leesburg VA, take Route 7 West. Passing 2 traffic lights after the Rt 340 exit for Berryville, turn Right on Russell Road (Rt 660).

* Go 3/10 mile, turn Right at large Keepstone Farm sign (Dog Gone Healthy sign below). Follow farm lane to Left turn at #412, and go to end of Driveway.

From the West: From I-81, Take Exit 315, Rt 7 East at Winchester VA. Go about 6 miles, and turn Left on Russell Road (Rt 660). Follow * directions above.

From the North: From Frederick MD, take Rt 340/15 South, bearing right on 340 South at the split. Follow 340 to Charles Town WV, and continue South on 340 to Rt 7 West at Berryville VA. Follow Rt 7 West through 2 traffic lights, to Russell Rd on right. Follow * directions above.

From the South: From Rt 66 West - Take Rt 17 North toward Paris VA. Take 17 to traffic light, and turn Left onto Rt 50 West toward Winchester. Follow Rt 50 W to a Right turn at Rt 340 North (Sheetz Station at light). After going through the towns of Boyce and Berryville, turn Left onto Rt 7 West. Follow * directions above.
