 request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary
 at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in <u>jump-height order</u> from "small to tall."
- Crating space is limited. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 4
 months of age on show grounds. All dogs present must be <u>on leash</u> or
 confined to their crates except when being judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor
 failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show
 Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
 Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations
 around the show grounds.
- The Club will be providing lunch for the judges and volunteers. Exhibitors may purchase lunch for \$5.00. Otherwise, food will not be available at the show site.
