Notice to Exhibitors

- All judging will be indoors.
- The building will open Friday at 9:00 AM, Saturday and Sunday at 7:00 AM.
- **CRATING:** Crating space is very limited, so plan on getting cozy with your neighbor and sharing where you can. No ex-pens. No unentered dogs or dogs under 4 months of age in the building.
- **You can help reduce the crowding!!** If you are not entered in sequential trials we request that you break down your crate and chair to make room for other exhibitors and their dogs. Capital Dog Training Club will make a room in the building available to stash your crate and chair so that you don't have to remove it totally from the building. Thank you for your cooperation.
- **CRATE SET-UP:** Crate set-up time will be available on Thursday night from 7:00 PM until the conclusion of the Rally Match.
- **TRANSFERS:**

Obedience transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the next level class and judges are available and the class has not reached its limit.

Rally transfers will be permitted in accordance with Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 13. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each rally trial.

Note:

Because of start times of trials, transfers from Trial 1 to Trial 2 on the same day may not be possible.

- Obedience and Rally classes will run in jump height order from "small—tall."
- Club members will be providing a pot luck luncheon for the judges and workers. Exhibitors may purchase lunch for \$5.00. Otherwise, food will not be available at the show site.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the show site for \$5.00.
- **Waiver of Rights – Animals in Distress:** All persons attending these dog shows waive any claim for damages should Capital Dog Training Club have to take action to remove an animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate.

Directions

From I-70: Take US 340W & US 15 South from Frederick towards Leesburg & Harpers Ferry; take US 15 South to Point Of Rocks/MD Route 28 (flashing yellow light immediately before Potomac River Bridge); turn left onto Route 28 and go approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Rock Hall Rd. (immediately after RR); site is one story building on left.

From Washington I-270: follow signs for Route 340 to Route 15 South and follow as above.

From the West: From Leesburg, follow US 15 North, immediately after crossing the Potomac River Bridge, turn right onto Route 28 in Point of Rocks. Turn Right on Rock Hall Rd., just after crossing the railroad tracks. Turn left into the parking lot.
