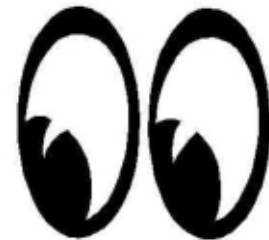

Obedience Judge Biographies

Frank Cardillino

A retired engineer, I have been in the sport of purebred dogs since 1972 with Afghan Hounds, Weimaraners, Dobermans and then Portuguese Water Dogs. Have owned and continue to own Portuguese Water Dogs and have been a member of the Portuguese Water Dog Club of America since 1993.

The experience of exhibiting in Confirmation, Agility, Portuguese Water Dog Trials and Obedience over the past 3 decades, has prepared me to become an AKC obedience judge. Judging obedience trials is a commitment to the sport at the highest level and a way to help continue the tradition of obedience training and trialing. As an obedience judge, I have the opportunity to see the best of the best in obedience competition as well as help guide the new exhibitors into this rewarding and fun sport.

I have been an obedience instructor for three clubs, have served as the training director for Salisbury KC, in addition to Obedience Trial Chair for the Portuguese Water Dog Club National and Salisbury KC, and a Portuguese Water Dog Club of America Water Trial Judge since 2009 and an AKC Obedience judge since 2009. A current member of Salisbury Kennel Club.

Betsy Horn Humer (*Eastern Waters'*)

I have been active in the sport of dogs all my life. My parents, Dan & Janet Horn, established Eastern Waters' Kennels in 1947. They were both obedience judges and I thought it was a natural transition to also judge obedience. They are the authors of The New Complete Chesapeake Bay Retriever.

I grew up with Chesapeakees, training, showing and going to dog shows. When my husband, Rupe and I established our own household in 1965 we were given a puppy for Christmas. The rest as they say, "is history". CH Eastern Waters' Oak, CD, TD, WD was a two-time National Specialty winner. Our dogs are breed champions with titles are both ends: obedience, agility, tracking, rally, Junior Hunter and WD titles. Our stud dogs have sired Best in Show winners, an OTCH, a MACH and the first Versatile Companion Dog 4 (VCD#4) in our breed. We have bred dogs who were trained to Master Hunter/ Senior Hunter titles, VCD3 titles and multiple group placements. I continue to train and show my own dogs in conformation and performance events. I have met requirements to be an AKC Breeder of Merit.

I have been approved to judge Chesapeake Bay Retrievers for 30 years and to judge the Sporting Group and the Herding Group, plus all obedience and Rally classes, J.S. and Best in Show. This is my 25th year of judging obedience. I have been a member of the American Chesapeake Club for over 50 years, have just served a three year term on the Board of Directors and currently serve as Judges Education Coordinator to the AKC. I also belong to Salisbury Maryland Kennel Club and am a Life Member of Bayshore Companion Dog Club in New Jersey. We lived in New Jersey until 1999 and nineteen years ago moved to the Eastern Shore of Virginia, nestled between the Chesapeake Bay and the Atlantic Ocean. We like to say that we brought our dogs "back to their roots". Now my question for all of you is "Are You Ready"?

Cheryl Pratt

I became involved with dog obedience in the late 1980's when our family brought home a Great Dane puppy. Up until then I had always had small dogs. Knowing this boy would outweigh me I found a local training club and enrolled in a basic obedience class. Like most of us involved in the sport of obedience I was hooked. Over the next 25 years I trained two more Great Danes, a Labrador Retriever and a rescued Greyhound from the track earning four more CD's and two CDX's. I now have two Vizslas. One with an RAE and a UD. I'm just starting to show my young boy who has earned his CD, BN, RI and PCD.

I became involved with rally when it first started in 2005 after attending a seminar with a friend who convinced me to apply to be a judge. Judging rally was so much fun that I decided to apply for obedience. I am now a Novice, Open and Utility Obedience judge. I am a member of the Mount Vernon Dog Training Club in Northern Virginia. I am also the Assistant Training Director and the Trial Secretary.

It's such a joy to watch a team having fun and working together in the ring. I would like to wish everyone good luck, remember to breathe and make sure you hug your dog when you leave the ring.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable if a legible e-mail address is included on the entry form.

Important Information Regarding Email Communications: Exhibitors providing email addresses will receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule, through email. Please ensure all spam-blocking technology is set to allow email from the secretary address listed in the premium. Check spam and junk folders regularly. Some communications will contain .pdf attachments.

All entries must indicate class "A" or "B" and a jump height for classes that require jumps.

Processing fee per entry using PayPal method: \$2.50 (non-refundable) which is already added to the entry fee amount for your "cart."

Be sure to include the AKC number of the dog being paid for so that we can match payment to entry forms.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules section of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.) No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Returned checks, post-dated checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Notice to Exhibitors

- All judging will be indoors.
- Crating space is limited, so plan on getting cozy with your neighbor and sharing where you can. Crate set-up time will be available on Thursday night from 7:00 PM until the conclusion of the Rally Match.

• TRANSFERS:

Obedience transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the next level class and judges are available and the class has not reached its limit.

Rally transfers will be permitted in accordance with Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each rally trial.

Note: Because of start times of trials, transfers from Trial 1 to Trial 2 may not be possible.

- The Rally ring is 40 x 50 feet. The Friday Rally trials will run concurrently but will have staggered start times. Judging times will be scheduled to minimize conflicts for exhibitors who enter both trials.
- A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day.
- Obedience and Rally classes will run in jump height order from "small—tall." Your jump height must be included on the entry form for all classes that require a jump.
- Club members will be providing a pot luck luncheon for the judges and workers. Exhibitors may purchase lunch for \$5.00. Otherwise, food will not be available at the show site.
- **REFUND POLICY:**
Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience or rally trials. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the show site for \$5.00.

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms, additional charges and delivery policies.

Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.
