# Important “Covid-19” Trial Info

## Please read! Things you can expect on trial days:

- As of the publishing of this judging schedule, we expect the trial to go on as described. All trial decisions will be in accordance with Maryland state and local guidelines in place at the time of the trial.
- In the event that the trial needs to be canceled because of virus restrictions, we will notify all exhibitors via email and it will be posted on [www.clantyre.net](http://www.clantyre.net). Exhibitors can also check the AKC Events Cancellation hotline.
- Catoctin Kennel Club is making every effort to supply a safe trial environment. However, exhibitors are entering the trial at their own risk.

## Other things you can expect on trial days:

- There will be **no** indoor crating for exhibitors. Please come prepared to work from your car. Spectators will not be allowed in the building.
- A limited number of dog/handler teams will be allowed in the building at one time.
- Traffic flow in and out of the building will be clearly marked. Steward/Club Members will be helping with traffic flow and alerting exhibitors on what is happening in the rings. Pay attention and follow instructions for a smooth-running transition into and out of the building.
- Parking: Leave some “social space” between cars when parking, expect to work from your car.
- Social distancing will remain in effect. Masks will be required when inside the building, including when in the ring working your dog.
- Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be displayed in several places. Come prepared to photograph the map for your personal use.
- Check-in and armband pick-up area will be clearly marked.
- Food will not be available onsite. Plan on bringing your own lunch, water, drinks, ice, etc.
- Briefings/walkthroughs: Expect distance briefings, smaller walkthroughs.
- Ribbons may be self-serve.
- Exhibitors are expected to follow state, local government, event and facility guidelines.

# Notice to Exhibitors

- All judging will be indoors.
- The building will open one hour prior to the start of judging each day.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfers will be accepted prior to the day of the trial. Requests should be emailed to: [showsec@clantyre.net](mailto:showsec@clantyre.net) or mailed to: Clantyre Show Secretary Services, 5474 Delphinium Ct., Columbia, MD 21045.
- There will be NO indoor crating for exhibitors. Please come prepared to work from your car. Spectators will not be allowed in the building.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- For your convenience, totals have been carefully tabulated. Neither the Club nor the Show Secretary assumes responsibility for absolute accuracy.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

# Important Information for All Trials

A walk-through (for handlers without their dogs) will take place prior to Rally classes, Obedience Novice A, Beginner Novice, and Preferred Novice classes. Walkthroughs may be combined or split at the judge's discretion. Class judging will immediately follow the walkthrough in the order listed.

Note: Rally transfers will be allowed between the AM trial and PM trial, but **MUST** be completed by 12:30 PM.

If the published judge and ring are available prior to the listed start time and all exhibitors have checked in and agree, the judge may start a class earlier than the class time listed.

Judges will take a luncheon break at their discretion, which may impact these start times.

COVID-19 precautions will take additional time. Please be patient!

## Directions

From I-70: Take US 340W & US 15 South from Frederick towards Leesburg & Harpers Ferry; take US 15 South to Point Of Rocks/MD Route 28 (flashing yellow light immediately before Potomac River Bridge); turn left onto Route 28 and go approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Rock Hall Road (immediately after RR); site is one story building on left.

From Washington I-270: Follow signs for Route 340 to Route 15 South and follow as above.

From the West: From Leesburg, follow US 15 North, immediately after crossing the Potomac River Bridge, turn right onto Route 28 in Point of Rocks. Turn Right on Rock Hall Rd., just after crossing the railroad tracks. Turn left into the parking lot.
