

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ❖ All judging will be indoors.
- ❖ Move-ups will be allowed for both the Obedience and Rally trials. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- ❖ **Crating information:** The trial site will not be available to exhibitors the day before the trial. Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. Due to space limitations, unentered dogs may be asked to leave. No dogs under 6 months of age on show grounds.
- ❖ Special instructions for #6822 ("Agility" building): Mats must be placed under crating on the green flooring. Soft crates ONLY.
- ❖ Fast food is available within 2 miles.
- ❖ There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Exercise areas will be marked. Please pick up after your dog. Dogs shall not be allowed to "potty" on or around landscaped areas. This will be strictly enforced!
- ❖ Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- ❖ All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in jump-height order.  
Saturday (SMDTC): Small - Tall in ascending catalog order  
Sunday (HTDC): Tall - Small in descending catalog order
- ❖ Limited handicapped parking will be available on the CTA lot. Additional parking: A parking is enclosed. Camper hook-ups not available. Free admission/Free parking.
- ❖ The judge is not required to wait for dogs. Each handler is responsible for being ready at ringside when required and without being called.
- ❖ All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads in the building.
- ❖ A limited number of catalogs will be on sale at the show site.
- ❖ All persons attending this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damaged against the host clubs or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

#### **PARKING MAP**

#### **DIRECTIONS**

##### **From Montgomery County and Points West:**

Beltway (I 495) East to I 95 North, to Exit 29A (East) Beltsville, onto Rt. 212 (Powder Mill Rd.) Continue on Rt. 212 across Rt. 1 to next traffic light. Turn Left onto Edmonston Rd. Go North about 2 miles, turn Left onto Distribution Dr. (tall sign at corner: Shepherd Electric). Go past 84 Lumber on the Right and turn Right at next driveway.

##### **From Points East:**

Take Beltway (I 495 or 95) West to Exit 23A, Kenilworth Ave. (Rt. 201). Go North 4 miles, turn Left at Distribution Dr. (Shepherd Electric sign), follow directions as above.

##### **From Points North:**

I-95 South to Exit 29A (Calverton/Beltsville, Rt. 212 Exit), go East on Rt. 212 (Powder Mill Rd.) and follow directions as above for Montgomery County.
