

- Free admission/Free parking.
- Parking spaces immediately in front of building 6826 and beyond are reserved for Show Committee and additional Handicapped vehicles.

Dogs are not allowed to "potty" on or around landscaped areas! This will be strictly enforced, as our parking is in jeopardy. (Please remember: Not picking up after your dog is grounds for a Committee hearing!)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Free admission/Free parking. Please park only in designated areas. A map is enclosed.
- All judging will be indoors.
- Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave.
 No dogs under 6 months of age on show grounds.
- Special instructions for #6822 ("Agility" building): Mats must be placed under crating on the green flooring. Soft crates ONLY.
- Requests for Move-ups must be done at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial and presented to the Show Secretary in writing.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- Dogs shall not be allowed to "potty" on or around landscaped areas. This will be strictly enforced! Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- The largest exercise area is through the door in the back of each building. Cleanup supplies will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All class prizes will be awarded in the ring when judging of that class is over.
 Special prizes will be awarded at the end of regular classes. None will be mailed.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads in the building.
- Lunch will not be available at the show site, but there is fast food available within 2-3 miles either direction on Route 1.
- All persons attending this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against the Dog Owners' Training Club of Maryland, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Pursuant to Maryland Code, §21.1004.1(a): "A person may not leave a cat or dog unattended in a standing or parked motor vehicle in a manner that endangers the health or safety of the cat or dog."

The Prince George's County Police Department will be notified if we feel that your dog may be in danger.

DIRECTIONS

From Montgomery County and Points West:

Beltway (I 495) East to I 95 North, to Exit 29A (East) Beltsville, onto Rt. 212 (Powder Mill Rd.) Continue on Rt. 212 across Rt. 1 to next traffic light. Turn Left onto Edmonston Rd. Go North about 2 miles, turn Left onto Distribution Dr. (tall sign at corner: Shepherd Electric). Go past 84 Lumber on the Right and turn Right at next driveway.

From Points East:

Take Beltway (I 495 or 95) West to Exit 23A, Kenilworth Ave. (Rt. 201). Go North 4 miles, turn Left at Distribution Dr. (tall sign at corner: Shepherd Electric), follow directions as above.

From Points North:

I-95 South to Exit 29A (Calverton/Beltsville, Rt. 212 Exit), go East on Rt. 212 (Powder Mill Rd.) and follow directions as above for Montgomery County.
