DIRECTIONS

From I-495 / I-95

From I-495/95, use Exit 23 (Route 201 – Kenilworth Avenue). Go north 4.2 miles to Distribution Drive, turn left. Note that Route 201 starts as Kenilworth Avenue, changes to Edmonston Road and then to Old Baltimore Pike. *

From I-95 (South or North)

From I-95 South or North, take Exit 29A – Powder Mill Road (changes to Ammendale Road at light). Go to Virginia Manor Road, turn left. At light at Murkirk Road, turn right. At light at Old Baltimore Pike, turn right. * Follow Old Baltimore Pike to Distribution Road and turn right at Shepherds Electric Company. 6822/6828 Distribution Drive is on right past after a curve to the left.

PARKING MAP



- Please park only in designated areas.
- No overnight or RV parking available.
- Free admission/Free parking.
- Parking spaces immediately in front of building 6826 and beyond are reserved for Show Committee and additional Handicapped vehicles.

The business neighbors shown on the map as “Show Parking” are graciously allowing us to park on their private lots.

Dogs are not allowed to “potty” on or around landscaped areas! This will be strictly enforced, as our parking is in jeopardy. (Please remember: Not picking up after your dog is grounds for a Committee hearing!)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Free admission/Free parking. Please park only in designated areas. A map is enclosed.
- All judging will be indoors.
- Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave. Dogs under the age of 4 months are prohibited from the grounds of AKC events.
- **Special instructions** for #6822 (“Agility” building): Mats must be placed under crating on the green flooring. Soft crates ONLY.
- Transfers will be allowed for both the Obedience and Rally trials. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- Dogs shall not be allowed to “potty” on or around landscaped areas. This will be strictly enforced! Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- Clean-up supplies will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All class prizes will be awarded in the ring when judging of that class is over. None will be mailed.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads in the building.
- Lunch will not be available at the show site, but there is fast food available within 2-3 miles either direction on Route 1.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- All persons attending this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against the Dog Owners’ Training Club of Maryland, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
