There is plenty of crating space available. No ex-pens. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Directions to the Trial Site

From the North, East, or South:

Follow I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) to Exit 19 (I-795) towards Owings Mills/Reisterstown continuing until the expressway ends. Bear right onto Route 140 West (towards Westminster) continuing for 10.9 miles to the light at Center Street. Turn left at the light onto Center Street. Proceed 1.6 miles through a four-way stop sign and two traffic lights. Go past the Farm Museum on the right and Carroll Hospital on the left and you will be at the stop sign at Gist Road. Turn right onto Gist Road. Drive 0.1 miles and turn right onto Ag Center drive.

From the East or South - Alternate route (more back road driving):

Take Route 32 West (to Sykesville/Westminster). Turn left on Kate Wagner Road. Turn right onto Gist Road. After you pass Smith Ave turn left onto Ag Center drive.

From the West:

From I- 70 Exit 68 – Route 27 North to right onto Kate Wagner Rd. Turn left onto Gist Road and follow alternate route directions above.

From I-70 Exit 76 – Route 97 North to left on Hook Road. Turn right onto Gist Road and follow alternate route directions above.

From I-70 Exit 80 – Route 32 West. Left onto Kate Wagner Rd. Right onto Gist Road and follow alternate route directions above.
