- All judging will be held indoors, on mats over concrete, with ring gating surrounding each ring. The obedience/rally area of the building has no heating or air-conditioning, but is well ventilated.
- Crating: The building will be open to set up crates for both trials starting at 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, October 3. Crates may be left in the building overnight, but must be removed at the close of the trial on Thursday. October 4. No ex-pens or grooming tables allowed inside the building.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC events.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. NO Flexi-Leads in the building.
- Food is available on site.
- There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of **trash** in the proper manner.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Free admission/Free parking. All Fire Lanes must be kept clear at all times. Vehicles left in Fire Lanes will be towed at the owner's expense.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. Each handler is responsible for being ready at ringside when required and without being called.
