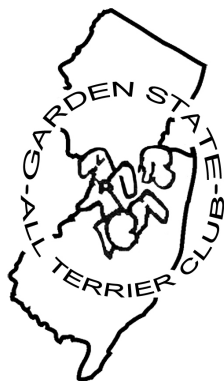

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (Visa, MasterCard or Discover) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$4.00 per dog. All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. You may wish to call to confirm receipt of your fax, as proof of transmission is not proof of receipt (Phone: 410-997-3698).

If you would like to know the status of your entry, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. E-mail confirmations will be sent as soon as the entry is processed. Just include your (legible) e-mail address on the entry form.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Full refund will be given to Bitches in Season with a written notice from their Veterinarian. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms additional charges and delivery policies. Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.

Notice to Exhibitors

All judging will be held indoors.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC events.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

NO Flexi-Leads in the building.

Food may not be available onsite. Plan on bringing your own lunch.

There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of **trash** in the proper manner.

All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Free admission/Free parking.

The judge is not required to wait for dogs. Each handler is responsible for being ready at ringside when required and without being called.

Jump Height: Dogs will be placed in "small to tall" jump height order in both Obedience AND Rally. **Please include your jump height on your entry form.**

Rally ring size will be 40' x 50'.

Catalogs will be available pre-paid at the reduced price of \$6.00. A very limited number will be available at the show.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience/Rally trials. The Club will refund all but \$5 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason upon presentation of a signed note (on official business letterhead) from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season. The note must be presented to the Trial Secretary by the end of the trial on Wednesday, October 2.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Obedience and Rally transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Exhibitors providing email addresses may receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email.

Parking Rules

All Parking Rules will be enforced.

All Parkers must maintain the cleanliness and order of their assigned spot.

Anyone parking in an area other than one assigned by the Parking Committee/ Site Control will be subject to immediate removal from the Show Site at their expense and held financially responsible for any and all cost for damages caused to the grounds. **THE BASEBALL FIELDS ARE STRICTLY A NO PARKING ZONE -- KEEP OFF!**

Admittance to the Handicapped parking areas is in strict accordance to Pennsylvania State Law. ID Required.

No saving spaces for others with cones or ex-pens. Reserving additional space by any means will result in an additional fee.

No refund of any Parking fees. Receipts are available upon request.

Only one vehicle may accompany an RV/Trailer OR Box Van and is considered a "towed vehicle" and no additional fee is due.

Parking for a fee is available from 3 PM, Monday, Sept. 30th until 4 PM Saturday, October 5th. Parking prior to this or following these times is not permitted and is subject to police citation and fine. Parking on area public streets is subject to citation.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
