- Crating space is limited. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- Trial site will not be available to exhibitors the day before the trial.
- Fast food is available within 2 miles.
- There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in jump-height order. Saturday: Small-Tall in ascending catalog order Sunday: Tall – Small in descending catalog order
- Limited handicapped parking will be available on the CTA lot. Additional parking: A parking map is included. Camper hook-ups not available. Free admission/Free parking.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. Each handler is responsible for being ready at ringside when required and without being called.
- A limited number of catalogs will be on sale at the show site.



From Points East:

Take Beltway (I 495 or 95) West to Exit 23A, Kenilworth Ave. (Rt. 201). Go North 4 miles, turn Left at Distribution Dr. (Shepherd Electric sign), follow directions as above. **From Points North:**

I-95 South to Exit 29A (Calverton/Beltsville, Rt. 212 Exit), go East on Rt. 212 (Powder Mill Rd.) and follow directions as above for Montgomery County.
