- Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in jump-height order.



At light at Old Baltimore Pike, turn right. * Follow Old Baltimore Pike to Distribution Road and turn right at Shepherds Electric Company. 6822/6826 Distribution Drive is on right past after a curve to the left.
