- Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in jump-height order.



From I-95 South or North, take Exit 29A – Powder Mill Road (changes to Ammendale Road at light). Go to Virginia Manor Road, turn left. At light at Murkirk Road, turn right. At light at Old Baltimore Pike, turn right. * Follow Old Baltimore Pike to Distribution Road and turn right at Shepherds Electric Company. 6822/6826 Distribution Drive is on right past after a curve to the left.
