Important “Covid-19” Trial Info

Please read!

- **MOST IMPORTANT: If you are exhibiting signs of illness, have tested positive or have been otherwise told to self-quarantine due to known Covid-19 exposure, please stay home.**
- Crating will **not** be allowed in the building. Start times for each class have been published in the judging schedule so that exhibitors can time their arrival.
- We encourage exhibitors not to arrive until 30 minutes prior to the scheduled class start time.
- Spectators will not be allowed in the building.
- Building entries and exits will be clearly marked.
- Social distancing will remain in effect. Masks **will** be required when inside the building, including when in the ring working your dog.
- Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be displayed in several places. Come prepared to photograph the map for your personal use.
- Check-in and armband pick-up area will be clearly marked.
- Food will not be available onsite. Plan on bringing your own lunch, drinks, etc.
- Briefings/walkthroughs: Expect distance briefings, smaller walkthroughs.
- Exhibitors are expected to follow state, local government, event and facility guidelines.



Notice to Exhibitors

- All judging will be indoors.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- Food will not be available at the site. Fast food is available within 2 miles.
- Parking: Limited handicapped parking will be available on the CTA lot. Additional parking: A map is included. Camper hook-ups not available. Free parking.
- **REFUND POLICY:**
Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund 50% of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- **Waiver of Rights – Animals in Distress: Hyattsville Dog Training Club** reserves the right to remove an animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Please park only in designated areas.

Overnight/RV parking available in the parking area off Distribution Way.

Dogs shall not be allowed to “potty” on or around landscaped areas! This will be strictly enforced, as our parking is in jeopardy.

(Please remember: Parking in a “no parking” area and/or not picking up after your dog is grounds for a Committee hearing!)

Directions

From I-495 / I-95

From I-495/95, use Exit 23 (Route 201 – Kenilworth Avenue). Go north 4.2 miles to Distribution Drive, turn left. Note that Route 201 starts as Kenilworth Avenue, changes to Edmonston Road and then to Old Baltimore Pike. *

From I-95 (South or North)

From I-95 South or North, take Exit 29A – Powder Mill Road (changes to Ammendale Road at light). Go to Virginia Manor Road, turn left. At light at Muirkirk Road, turn right. At light at Old Baltimore Pike, turn right. * Follow Old Baltimore Pike to Distribution Road and turn right at Shepherds Electric Company. 6822/6828 Distribution Drive is on right past after a curve to the left.
