UDX/RAE/RACH Entries: Please check the box on the entry form for UDX/RAE/RACH. Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Utility B/Open B, Excellent B/Advanced B or Excellent B/Advanced B/Master. Once the limit has been reached in any class, entries will be returned in their entirety. UDX/RAE/RACH entries are eligible for the waiting list, but if *all* classes do not become available by closing, the multiple-class UDX/RAE/RACH entry will be returned and the next eligible waitlisted person will receive the slot.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the "reverse" side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.) No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No entry form will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Returned checks, post-dated checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Notice to Exhibitors

- Building Info: The site will be accessible to Exhibitors at 8:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday each day. This is a non-smoking facility.
- All judging will be indoors. The Rally ring is 40 x 50 feet.
- **Crating:** There will be a crating space adjacent to the rings. There is also a separate room available to crate your dogs. A tarp is required under all crates.
- Parking: Parking for exhibitors will be in the parking lots located in front of the Colonial K9 building, on the grass adjacent to and to the left of the building (when facing it) and on the auxiliary road located behind the building. There will be a designated parking space to drop off or unload. Please do this as quickly as possible so that others can use this space, too. Please do not park in that designated unloading space or any area that is marked with "No Parking" signs. There is no RV parking available.
- Food: Food will not be available on the trial site. Fast food locations are nearby.
- Transfers: Transfers will be allowed for both Obedience and Rally. Requests for a
 transfer must be in writing and submitted in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30
 minutes prior to the start of each trial on both Saturday and Sunday. (See Obedience
 Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15 for
 information on transfers.)
- Wait-list: A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that
 are withdrawn prior to the event closing day. Waitlist will be limited to 25 entries for
 Obedience, 25 entries for Rally.
- Obedience and Rally classes will run in jump height order from "tall small."

REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than the day before the start of the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- Please clean up after your dog(s)! Trash cans or bags are located on the property outside for pet waste. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crating area.
- Prohibited: No flexi-leads in the building. No strollers or dog whistles are permitted.
- No unentered dogs.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free
 of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate
 vaccinations
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.
- A limited number of catalogs will be available at the show site.

Directions

From the North: Take I-95 South to Exit 140 toward VA-630/Stafford. Turn left onto Courthouse Rd (VA-630). Turn right onto Jefferson Davis Hwy (US-1), then turn left onto Eskimo Hill Rd (VA-628). Turn left onto Big Spring Ln. Arrive at 30 Big Spring Lane, the trial is on your left.

- Dogs must be supervised by an owner/handler at all times.
- Only equipment designated for use at that time is to be used-any violation of this will result in dismissal from the property.
- Guests may park in designated parking areas only.
- Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior may be asked to leave without refund
- Unsafe handling of dogs and/or equipment, unsafe conduct, or damage to the property will result in dismissal from the property.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed on the property at any time.
