Step 3: **Include the AKC number of the dog being paid for so that we can match payment to entry forms.**

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms additional charges and delivery policies. Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Refunds of \$8 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No refund for duplicate entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Notice to Exhibitors

- **POLICIES REGARDING WORKING ON THE ARTIFICIAL TURF ARENA**

- * The following treats may be used on the turf: String cheese and slices of cheese, meat roll (non-crumbling), freeze dried treats, hot dogs, jerky treats, pupperoni, soft packaged treats (non-crumbling)
- * You may not use: Baby food, Braunschweiger, cheese puffs, cooked liver, cooked chicken, ground cooked meats, hard crunchy biscuits, popcorn, raw foods, yogurt.
- * You and your dog are required to pick up the treats from the turf.
- * **Please potty your dog often.** If there is an accident, there is a charge of \$5 to offset the cleaning of the turf.
- * Waterproof covering is required under crates and set-up areas.

- **REFUND POLICY**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- **TRANSFERS:** Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Please bring a clean tarp to put underneath your crates.
- LUNCH - will be on your own for all exhibitors. No food or beverages (other than water) are allowed in the arena.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.**

COVID-19 Social Distancing Plan Oriole Dog Training Club (ODTC)

AKC Obedience/Rally Trials - August 27-29, 2021

As of the publication of this premium, ODTC is following the State of Maryland's guidance with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic. Adjustments to this Plan will be made as needed should the State of Maryland and /or the AKC require any changes. Any updates to this Plan will be sent to exhibitors along with the judging program. Everyone who attends these trials is covered by this Plan as outlined below.

Any person who fails to follow this Plan and maintain at least six feet between individuals at all times during this event or on the show grounds during show hours may result in expulsion from this event.

WHEN TO STAY HOME – You should NOT attend the trial if you cannot answer YES to the following question on the waiver you will be asked to sign on the day of the trial: *“To the best of my knowledge, I am not infected with the virus SARS-CoV-2 or any other virus known to cause the disease currently referred to as COVID-19. I also state that I am free of symptoms of such infection including: **FEVER, COUGH, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, AND/OR PERSISTENT PAIN/PRESSURE IN THE CHEST.** I have also not to my knowledge been in direct contact with anyone diagnosed with **SARS-CoV-2 / COVID-19 / Coronavirus 2020** in the last 14 days nor have I been at any large event gathering where proper social distancing and masks were not enforced within the last 14 days”*. Please text the event secretary if you are unable to attend (Debbie Kaminski – 410-917-3775) and at that point, you will be refunded 50% of your entry fee. Anyone who attends a public gathering must recognize they will always be at a risk that they could contract COVID-19 despite all the precautions that will be taken to reduce that risk.
