- A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day.
- Obedience classes will run in jump height order from "Tall-Small." Your jump height <u>must be</u> included on the entry form for all classes that require a jump.

- Crating: Set-up will not be available on Friday. The building will open Saturday at 7:00 AM.
