## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This is a one-ring trial.
- Please park only in designated areas. A map is enclosed.
- All judging will be indoors.
- Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 6 months of age on show grounds.
- Requests for Move-ups must be done at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial and presented to the Show Secretary in writing.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- The exercise areas will be clearly marked. The largest is through the door in the back of the building. Please pick up after your dog. Clean-up supplies will be available.
- Dogs shall not be allowed to "potty" on or around landscaped areas. This will be strictly enforced! (Please remember: Not picking up after your dog is grounds for a committee hearing!)
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.
- All class prizes will be awarded in the ring when judging of that class is over. Special prizes will be awarded at the end of regular classes. None will be mailed.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads in the building.
