#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Please park only in designated areas. A map is enclosed.
- All judging will be indoors.
- Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 6 months of age on show grounds.
- Crating set-up will be allowed on Friday evening from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.
- Special instructions for #6822 ("Agility" building): Mats must be placed under crating on the green flooring. Soft crates ONLY.
- Requests for Move-ups must be done at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial and presented to the Show Secretary in writing.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Training mirrors will be covered during the trial.
- The exercise areas will be clearly marked. The largest is through the door in the back of each building. Please pick up after your dog. Clean-up supplies will be available.
- Dogs shall not be allowed to "potty" on or around landscaped areas. This will be strictly enforced! (Please remember: Not picking up after your dog is grounds for a committee hearing!)
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All class prizes will be awarded in the ring when judging of that class is over.
   Special prizes will be awarded at the end of regular classes. None will be mailed.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads in the building.
- Coffee and donuts will be available to all exhibitors prior to judging.
- Lunch will not be available at the show site, but there is fast food available within 2-3 miles either direction on Route 1.
- All persons attending this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against the Shetland Sheepdog Club or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.



#### DIRECTIONS

From Montgomery County and Points West:

Beltway (I 495) East to I 95 North, to Exit 29A (East) Beltsville, onto Rt. 212 (Powder Mill Rd.) Continue on Rt. 212 across Rt. 1 to next traffic light. Turn Left onto Edmonston Road (turns into Old Baltimore Pike). Go North about 2 miles, turn Left onto Distribution Dr. (tall sign at corner: Shepherd Electric). Go past 84 Lumber on the Right and turn Right at next driveway.

#### From Points East:

Take Beltway (I 495 or 95) West to Exit 23A, Kenilworth Ave. (Rt. 201). Go North 4 miles, turn Left at Distribution Dr. (tall sign at corner: Shepherd Electric), follow directions as above.

#### From Points North:

I-95 South to Exit 29A (Calverton/Beltsville, Rt. 212 Exit), go East on Rt. 212 (Powder Mill Rd.) and follow directions as above for Montgomery County.
