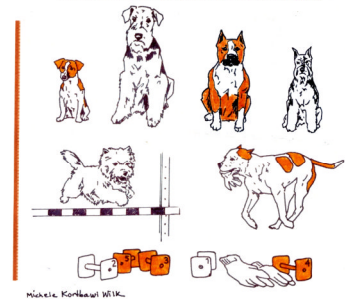

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ❖ All judging will be held indoors, on mats over concrete, with ring gating surrounding each ring. The obedience area of the building has no heating or air-conditioning, but is well ventilated.
- ❖ **Crating:** The building will be open to set up crates for both trials starting at 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 30. **No ex-pens** or grooming tables allowed inside the building.
- ❖ No dogs under six (6) months of age on show grounds.
- ❖ All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- ❖ **NO Flexi-Leads in the building.**
- ❖ **Food** is available on site.
- ❖ There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of **trash** in the proper manner.
- ❖ All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- ❖ Free admission/Free parking. All Fire Lanes must be kept clear at all times. Vehicles left in Fire Lanes will be towed at the owner's expense.
- ❖ **The judge is not required to wait for dogs.** Each handler is responsible for being ready at ringside when required and without being called.
- ❖ **Conflicts!** We will try our best to accommodate agility conflicts, although we offer no guarantee that we can resolve them all. **You can help by notifying the Obedience staff as soon as possible regarding potential conflicts.**
- ❖ **CATALOGS** will be available pre-paid for \$5.00. A very limited number will be available at the show.
- ❖ Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience trials. The Club will refund the entry fees for bitches unable to compete for that reason upon presentation of a signed note (on official business letterhead) from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season. The note must be presented to the Trial Secretary by the end of the trial on Thursday, October 2.
- ❖ **Obedience move-ups** will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- ❖ **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (**Visa or MasterCard**) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$3.50 per dog. All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. ❖ Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable. Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery.

❖ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

❖ **PLEASE make your entries correct and legible.** Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owner/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6)

❖ Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the AKC. Each Obedience 1st Entry Fee includes \$.50 AKC Recording Fee. Each Obedience Entry Fee includes a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2.) There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.

❖ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. 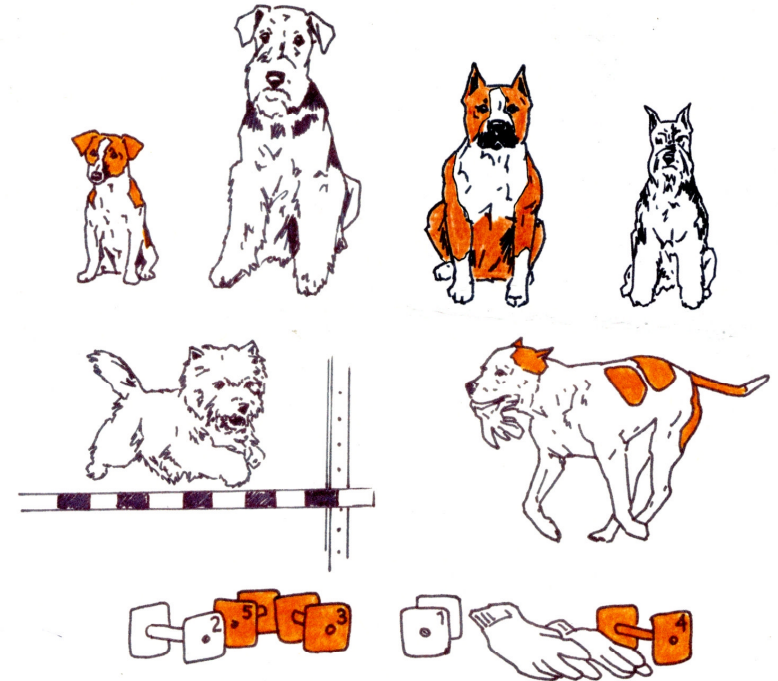
