NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- All judging will be held indoors, on mats over concrete, with ring gating surrounding each ring. The obedience area of the building has no heating or air-conditioning, but is well ventilated.
- Crating: The building will be open to set up crates for both trials starting at 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 30. No ex-pens or grooming tables allowed inside the building.
- No dogs under six (6) months of age on show grounds.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- NO Flexi-Leads in the building.
- Food is available on site.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Free admission/Free parking. All Fire Lanes must be kept clear at all times. Vehicles left in Fire Lanes will be towed at the owner's expense.

- Obedience move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.


