There will be a walkthrough prior to Rally classes, Obedience Beginner Novice, Novice A and Preferred Novice classes. Walkthroughs may be combined at the judge's discretion. Class judging will immediately follow the walkthrough in the order listed.

Walkthroughs may be combined at the judge's discretion.

Transfers for the Excellent, Advanced and Master classes will be placed in jump-height order.

### Notice to Exhibitors

- The building will be open for crate set-up at 1:00 PM on Friday. The building will open on Saturday and Sunday at 7:00 AM.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crating
  area. <u>Matting is required to be placed under all crates to protect the floors.</u> There is no space
  for un-entered dogs.
- All judging will be indoors.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- A limited number of catalogs will be on sale at the show site.

#### REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Waiver of Rights Animals in Distress: Talbot Kennel Club Inc. reserves the right to remove an animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.
