Important "Covid-19" Trial Info



- MOST IMPORTANT: If you are exhibiting signs of illness, have tested positive or have been otherwise told to self-quarantine due to known Covid-19 exposure, please <u>stay home</u>.
- CHECK-IN: TKC will conduct a no-contact temperature check when exhibitors pick up armbands and all exhibitors will be required to fill out a Covid-19 Waiver. The check-in and armband pick-up area will be clearly marked.
- There will be <u>no</u> indoor crating for exhibitors. Please come prepared to work from your car. (Exception: Workers will be able to crate in the building.) Spectators will not be allowed in the building. Traffic flow in and out of the building will be clearly marked.
- Three (3) dogs and exhibitors will be allowed in the building at one time (the dog working in the ring and the next two on deck.) Areas will be marked for the 2 "on deck" team with 2 warm-up areas available.
- Parking: Leave some "social space" between cars when parking, expect
 to work from your car. RV Parking will not be available. Exhibitors may
 park all the way around the building. There is one business open on
 Friday and one on Sunday. Their parking spaces will be marked as
 reserved.
- Social distancing will remain in effect.
- Masks will be required when in the building, including in the ring while working your dog.
- Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be displayed in several places. Come prepared to photograph the map for your personal use.
- Food will not be available onsite. Plan on bringing your own lunch, water, drinks, ice, etc.
- Briefings/walkthroughs: Expect distance briefings, smaller walkthroughs.
- Ribbons may be self-serve.
- Exhibitors are expected to follow state, local government, event and facility guidelines.

Notice to Exhibitors

- All judging will be indoors.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.

REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

 crate, and all persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim
 for damages against the club for such removal.
