Please read! We want you to know what to expect before entering.

- As of the publishing of this premium, we expect the trial to go on as described. All trial decisions will be in accordance with Maryland state and local guidelines in place at the time of the trial.
- Closing Date: Wednesday, August 19 at 6:00 PM.
- In the event that the trial needs to be canceled because of virus restrictions, we will notify all exhibitors via email no later than the closing date. (Checks will not be cashed.) After closing, the refund policy as detailed in this premium will remain in effect.
- Talbot Kennel Club is making every effort to supply a safe trial environment. However, exhibitors are entering the trial at their own risk.

Other things you can expect on trial days:

- There will be **no** indoor crating for exhibitors. Please come prepared to work from your car. (Exception: Workers will be able to crate in the building.) Spectators will not be allowed in the building. Traffic flow in and out of the building will be clearly marked.
- Three (3) dogs and exhibitors will be allowed in the building at one time (the dog working in the ring and the next two on deck.) Areas will be marked for the 2 "on deck" team with 2 warm-up areas available.

Notice to Exhibitors

- All judging will be indoors.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- Dogs will be arranged in jump height order "Tall to Small" for both obedience and rally. All entries for classes with jump heights MUST include jump height on the entry form.

Friday & Sunday: Tall-Small Saturday: Small-Tall

- The Rally ring is 40 x 50 feet.
- A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day.

REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their
