Note: Effective March 1, 1992: The American Kennel Club allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be show in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed Competition. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Junior Showmanship Competition

Novice Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

These trials will not offer entries for All-American Dogs/Mixed Breeds.

UDX & RAE entries:

Please check the box on the entry form for UDX (obedience) or RAE (rally).

Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Utility B and Open B (obedience) or Excellent B and Advanced B (rally).

Once the limit has been reached in either class, any subsequent UDX or RAE entries will be returned in their entirety.

Bitch in Season Refunds: The Club will refund all but \$5.00 dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. All refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. All requests must be received by the Show Secretary by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the show.

Obedience and Rally transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request to transfer must be presented in writing to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in jump-height order from Small-Tall.

Please include your jump height(s) on the entry form.

If a dog is entered in both Obedience and Rally, you must pay the fee for the first entry of the dog in EACH trial, as they are separate events.

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms additional charges and delivery policies. Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Refunds of \$8 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No refund for duplicate entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging. A dog determined to be ineligible, by its owner/agent, for the class in which it has been entered may be transferred to an eligible open class at a show prior to the judging of any regular conformation class within the sex of that breed or variety, and that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Notice To Exhibitors

The show grounds will be available Friday, January 31 for set-up from 5:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The building will open on Saturday and Sunday at 7:00 a.m.

****IMPORTANT NOTE****

Minimal chalking will be allowed in the grooming building. All exhibitors must have floor covering under grooming and crate set-ups. Exhibitors must provide their own floor covering. Owners and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around crating area.

Dogs may not be left at the show grounds overnight. Crates may be left.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

No strollers or flexi-leads in the building.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events.

Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.

All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.

Free admission/Free parking.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Dogs may not be left in closed vehicles without proper ventilation. If dogs are found in distress, TRSSCGP will take appropriate action.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Please read carefully. Many of the streets are unmarked. Look for “Washington County Fairgrounds” or “Washington Agricultural Fair” signs.

FROM I-70 East : Take Exit 17 (PA 18, Jefferson Ave). At the end of ramp, turn right on to PA 18 North. Follow PA 18 North for 1.3 miles. Turn right at the traffic light just past Jack's Muffler & Brake Shop. Follow road for 0.5 miles to stop sign. Bear left and continue 0.3 miles to Washington County Fairgrounds. Use entrance "C".

FROM I-70 West: Take Exit 17 (PA 18, Jefferson Ave). At end of ramp, turn right. Go 0.1 miles and turn right on to PA 18 North. Follow PA 18 North 1.1 miles. Turn right at traffic light. (No street sign, but just past Jack's Muffler & Brake shop on the right). Follow road for 0.5 miles to a stop sign. Bear left and continue 0.3 miles to the Washington County Fairgrounds (on North Main St.). Use Entrance "C".

FROM I-79: Take Exit 41 (Race Track Rd). Do NOT take exit 40. Look for the Washington County Fairgrounds or Washington Agricultural Fair signs at the end of the exit ramp. Go west (right turn from I-79 South, or left turn from I-79 North). Go 0.2 miles to a light and make a left turn on to Pike Street. Follow Pike Street for 0.7 miles to a light. Turn right at that light. Follow road for 1 mile to stop sign. Turn right at the stop sign. After 0.1 miles, the road will split - bear left on to North Main. Continue 0.9 miles to the Washington County Fairgrounds. Use entrance "C".

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
